Findings for 2025–26

Science lost 17.1 points

35.8% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 52.9% in 2024–25.

Grade 5 Math gained 17.2 points

58.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 41.2% in 2024–25.

Math is 5.8 points above the state

Altamaha Elementary School reported 51.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Science is 11.2 points below the Appling County average

35.8% here vs. 47.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Math gained 10.1 points

51.0% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 40.9% in 2024–25.

Grade 5 Science lost 17.1 points

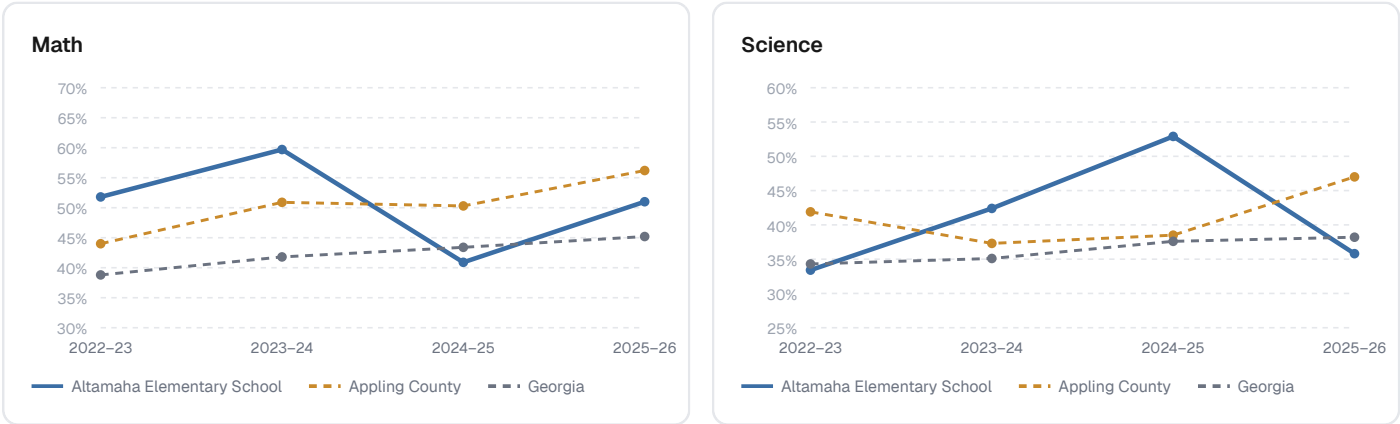
