Appling County Primary School reported 71.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

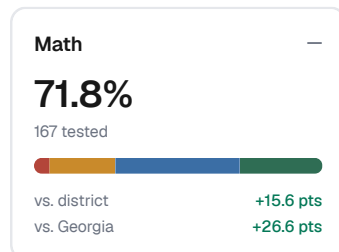
Math is 15.6 points above the Appling County average

Percent of students scoring Proficient or Distinguished, with the change from last year and the distance to the district and state averages.

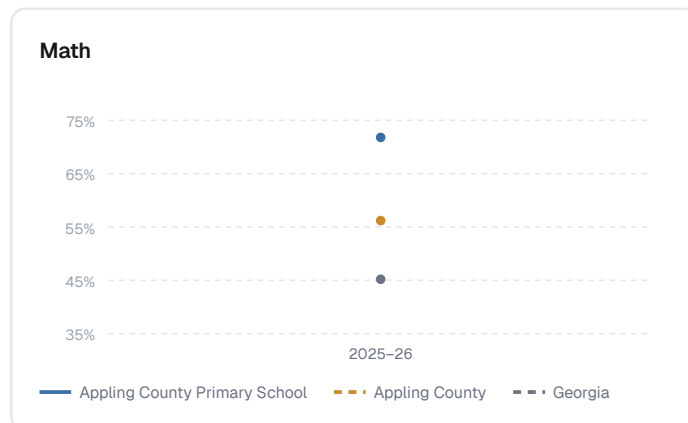
