Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math gained 10.6 points

53.7% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 43.1% in 2024–25.

Grade 5 Math gained 18.3 points

51.6% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 33.3% in 2024–25.

Math is 8.5 points above the state

Fourth District Elementary School reported 53.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Science is 11.5 points below the Appling County average

35.5% here vs. 47.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Science lost 3.4 points

35.5% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 38.9% in 2024–25.

Grade 4 Math gained 13.0 points

47.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 34.4% in 2024–25.

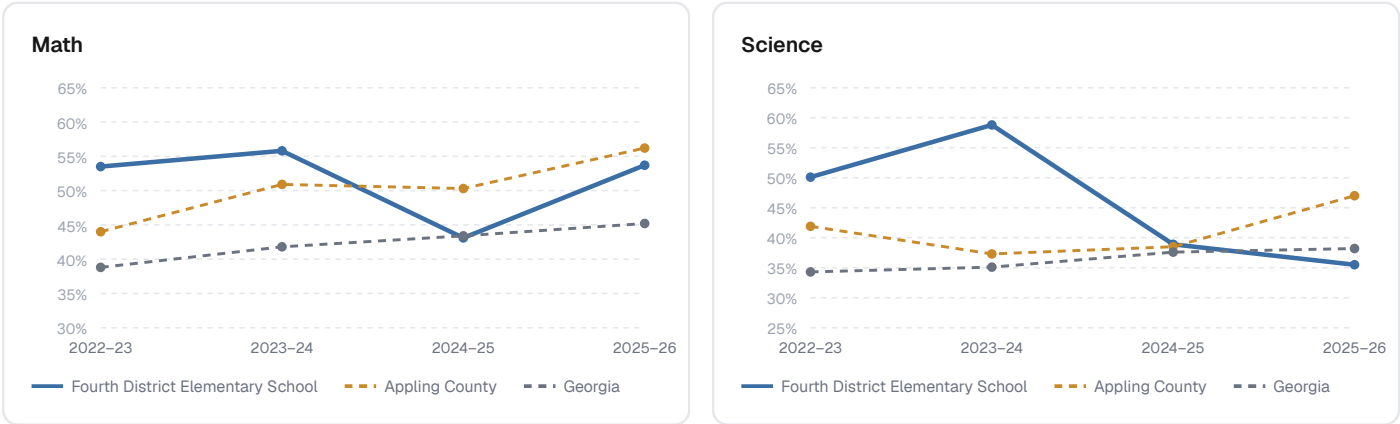
