## WHAT STANDS OUT

### Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

#### Science lost 5.6 points

51.9% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 57.5% in 2024–25.

#### Biology has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

59.6% → 61.6% → 64.9% → 66.3% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+6.7 pts overall).

#### The Limited English Proficient gap in Algebra: C&C narrowed by 29.4 points

Limited English Proficient sat 40.7 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 11.3 points behind them in 2025–26.

#### Grade 3 Math gained 6.5 points

67.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 61.3% in 2024–25.

#### US History is 29.8 points above the state

Bryan County reported 68.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.5%.

#### Algebra: C&C is 29.2 points above the First District average

76.2% here vs. 47.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

English Language Arts results for 2025–26 have not been published yet — GaDOE releases them after standard setting on the revised standards. Every total in this report covers the published subjects only.

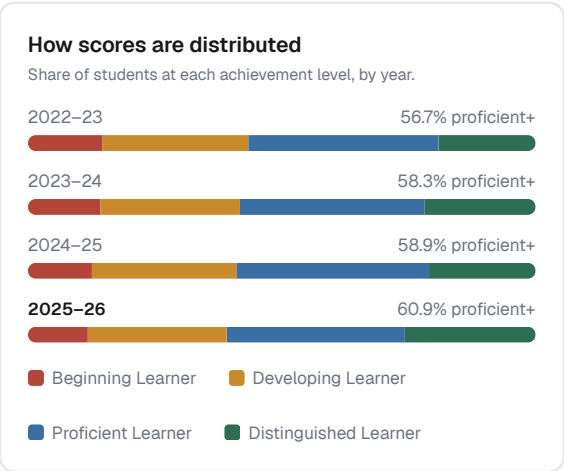
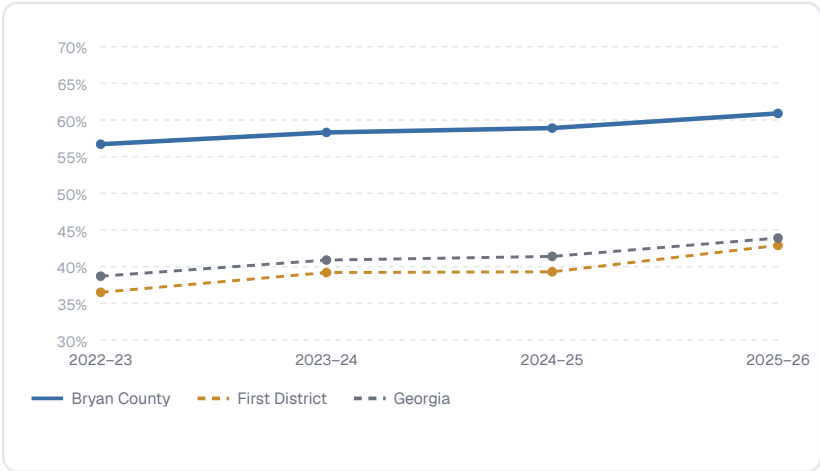

# High school course results

Georgia Milestones End-of-Course assessments taken in this district.

Georgia changed its end-of-course lineup during this period: Algebra I, American Literature and Composition were replaced by Algebra: Concepts and Connections. Year-over-year comparison across that change is not like-for-like.
