WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math gained 3.8 points

55.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 51.6% in 2024–25.

Science has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

38.5% → 44.8% → 50.7% → 53.1% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+14.6 pts overall).

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math narrowed by 13.6 points

Students with Disabilities sat 36.1 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 22.5 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 5 Math gained 9.7 points

50.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 41.0% in 2024–25.

Science is 14.9 points above the state

Bryan County Elementary School reported 53.1% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Math is 7.3 points below the Bryan County average

55.4% here vs. 62.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

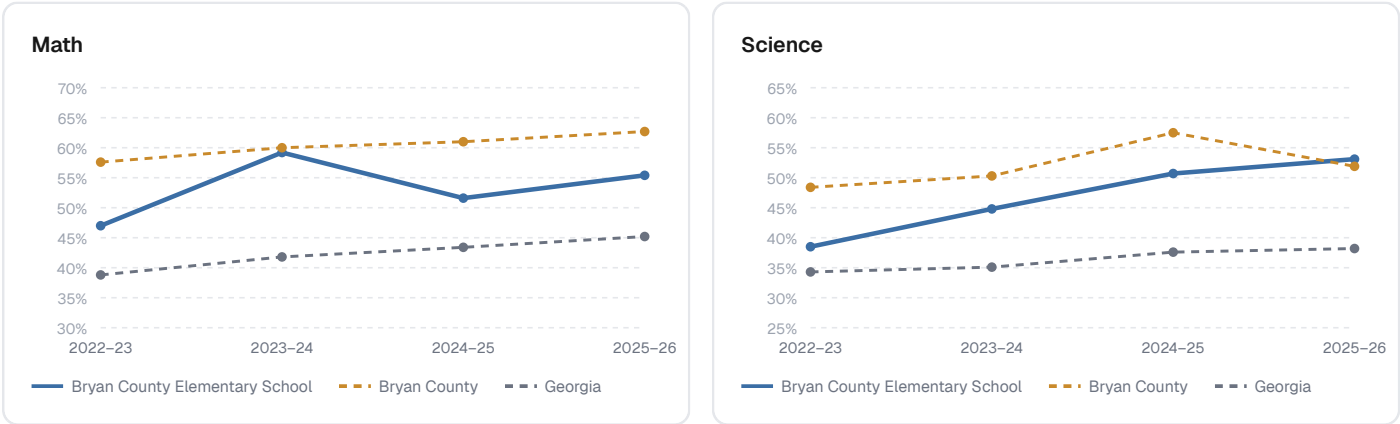
