Science lost 13.8 points

57.7% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 71.5% in 2024–25.

Grade 5 Science lost 13.8 points

57.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 71.5% in 2024–25.

Math is 20.3 points above the state

Dr. George Washington Carver Elementary School reported 65.5% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

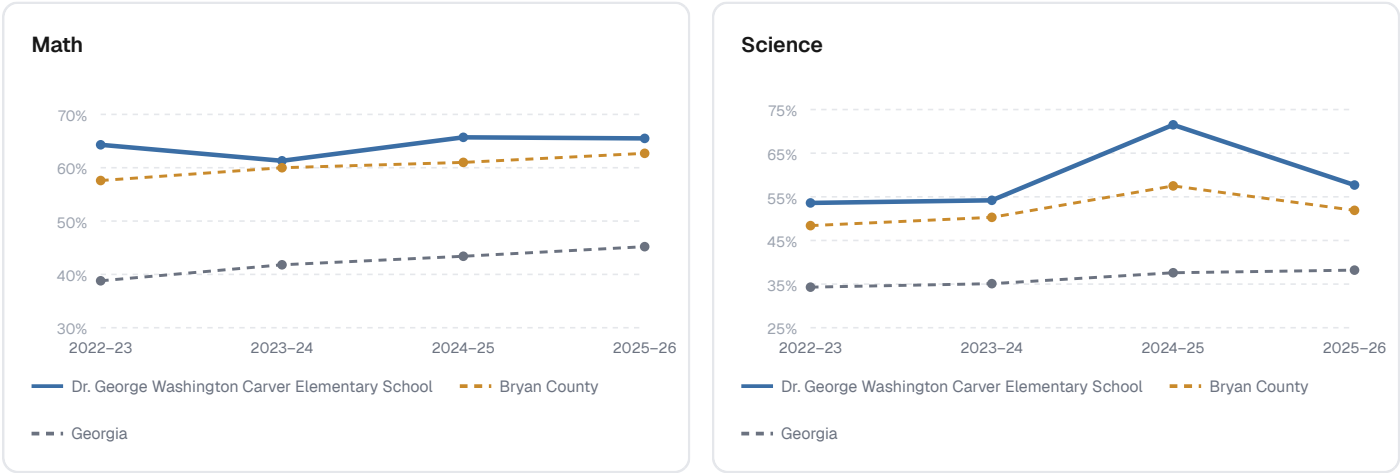
