Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math gained 9.9 points

66.2% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 56.3% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math widened by 7.5 points

Students with Disabilities sat 31.1 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 38.6 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 3 Math gained 9.9 points

66.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 56.3% in 2024–25.

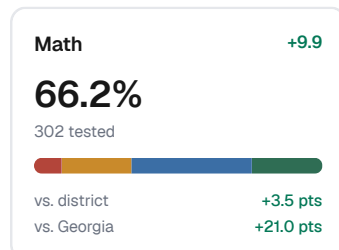
Math is 21.0 points above the state

Richmond Hill Elementary School reported 66.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Percent of students scoring Proficient or Distinguished, with the change from last year and the distance to the district and state averages.

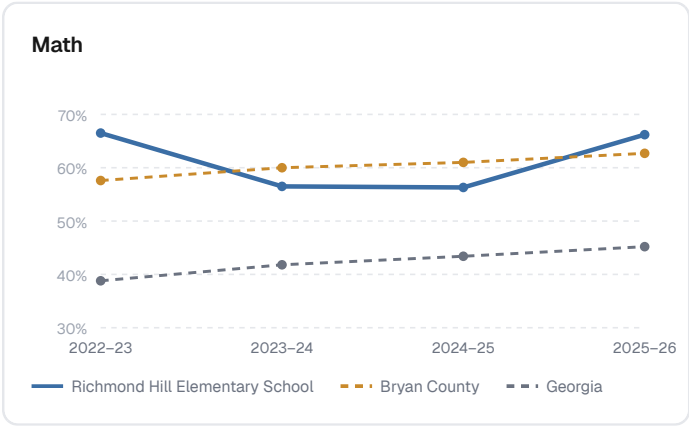


■ Beginning Learner ■ Developing Learner ■ Proficient Learner ■ Distinguished Learner
