WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Science gained 6.5 points

70.6% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 64.1% in 2024–25.

Grade 3 Math gained 18.4 points

70.5% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 52.1% in 2024–25.

Science is 32.4 points above the state

Brooklet Elementary School reported 70.6% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Science is 30.8 points above the Bulloch County average

70.6% here vs. 39.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Grade 4 Math lost 17.0 points

57.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 74.2% in 2024–25.

Math is 20.5 points above the state

Brooklet Elementary School reported 65.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

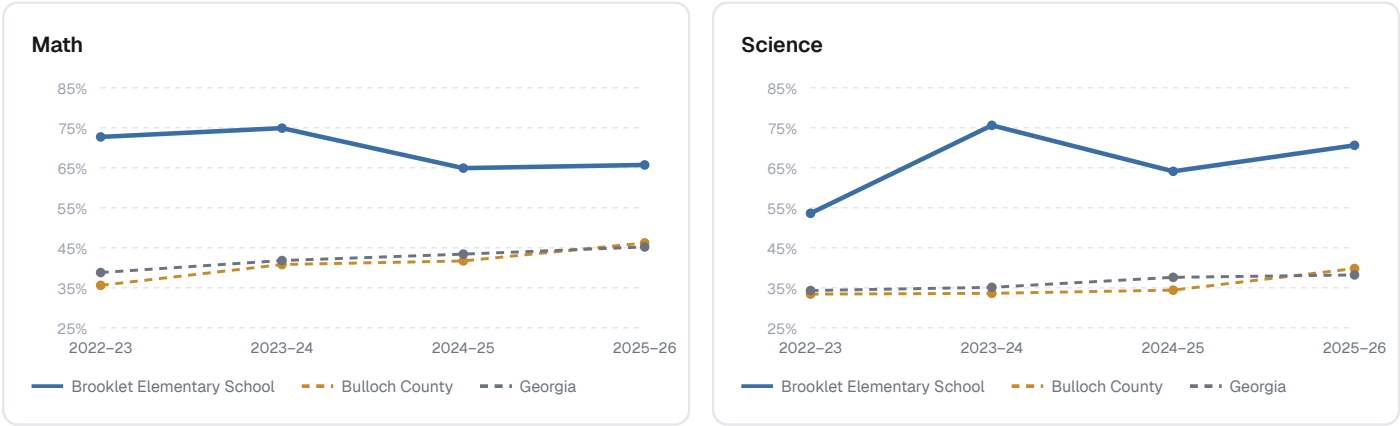
