Science gained 19.9 points

61.2% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 41.3% in 2024–25.

Grade 5 Science gained 19.9 points

61.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 41.3% in 2024–25.

Science is 23.0 points above the state

Julia P. Bryant Elementary School reported 61.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Science is 21.4 points above the Bulloch County average

61.2% here vs. 39.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Math gained 7.8 points

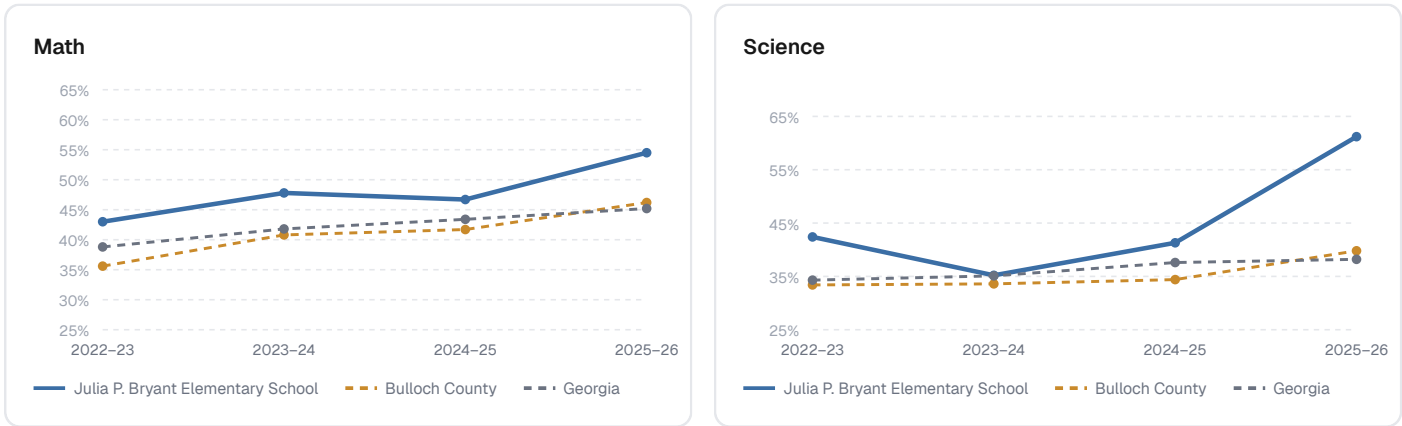
