WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math gained 10.5 points

47.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 36.9% in 2024–25.

Math has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

32.4% → 34.2% → 36.9% → 47.4% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+15.0 pts overall).

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math widened by 11.0 points

Students with Disabilities sat 35.1 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 46.1 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 3 Math gained 16.6 points

45.9% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 29.3% in 2024–25.

Science is 14.6 points below the state

Sallie Zetterower Elementary School reported 23.6% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Science is 16.2 points below the Bulloch County average

23.6% here vs. 39.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

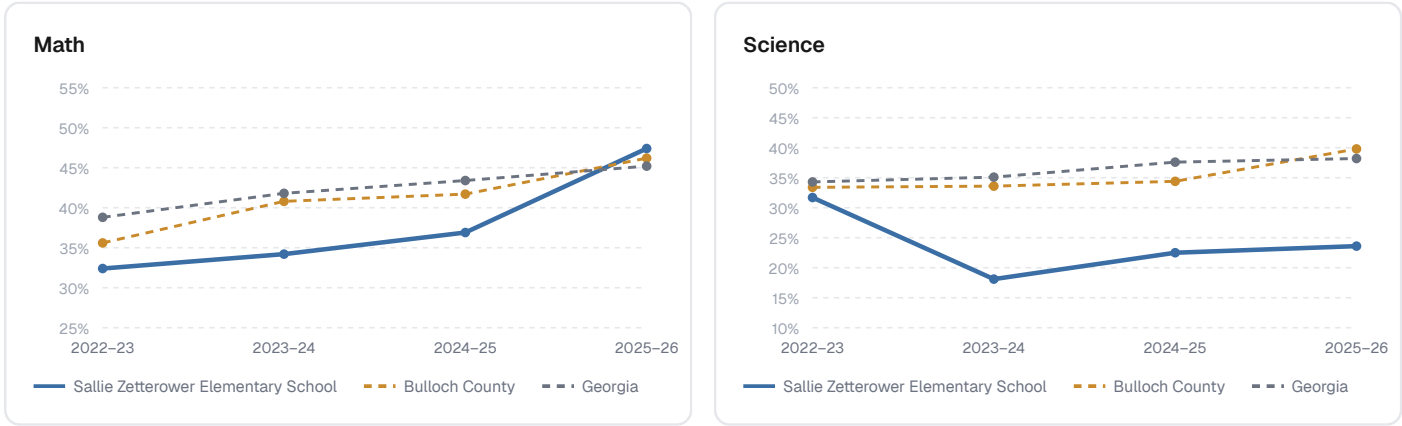
