WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Science gained 19.5 points

59.5% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 40.0% in 2024–25.

Math has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

23.6% → 35.8% → 45.9% → 56.5% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+32.9 pts overall).

Grade 5 Science gained 19.5 points

59.5% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 40.0% in 2024–25.

Science is 21.3 points above the state

Stilson Elementary School reported 59.5% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Science is 19.7 points above the Bulloch County average

59.5% here vs. 39.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Math gained 10.6 points

56.5% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 45.9% in 2024–25.

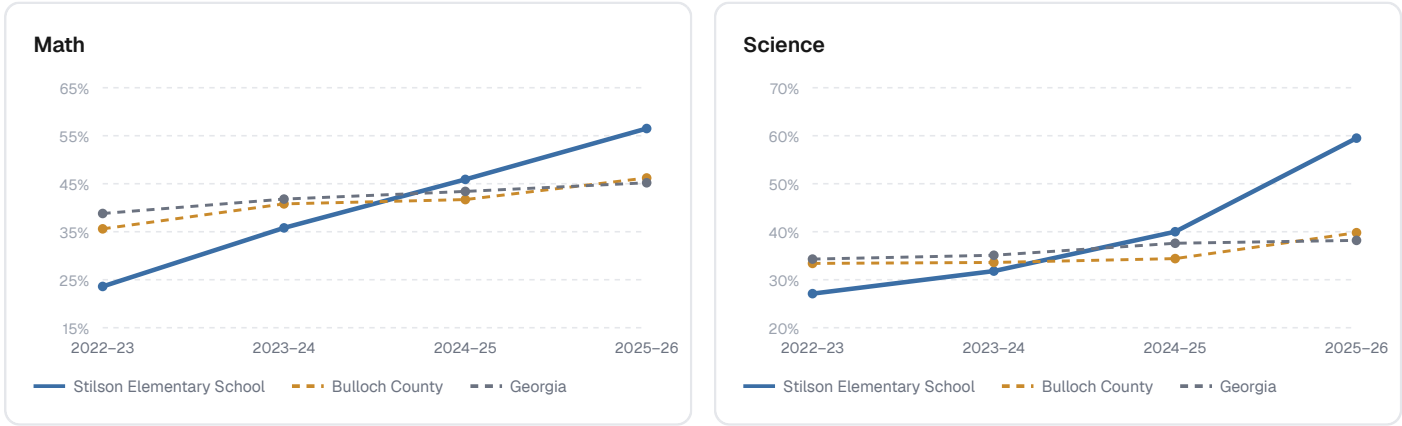
