WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Science gained 26.3 points

61.0% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 34.7% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Science widened by 31.2 points

Students with Disabilities sat 6.5 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 37.7 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 5 Science gained 26.3 points

61.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 34.7% in 2024–25.

Science is 22.8 points above the state

David L Rainer Elementary School reported 61.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Math gained 7.8 points

58.2% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 50.4% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math widened by 14.9 points

Students with Disabilities sat 23.0 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 37.9 points behind them in 2025–26.

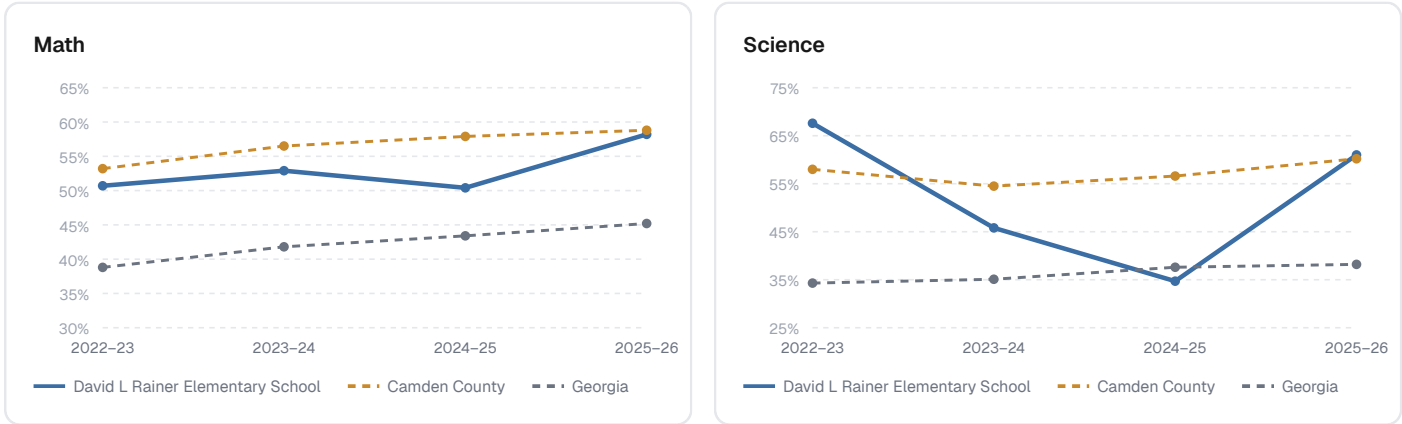
