Science lost 27.2 points

64.3% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 91.5% in 2024–25.

Grade 5 Science lost 27.2 points

64.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 91.5% in 2024–25.

Science is 26.1 points above the state

Kingsland Elementary School reported 64.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Math is 11.8 points above the Camden County average

70.6% here vs. 58.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Math lost 3.6 points

70.6% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 74.2% in 2024–25.

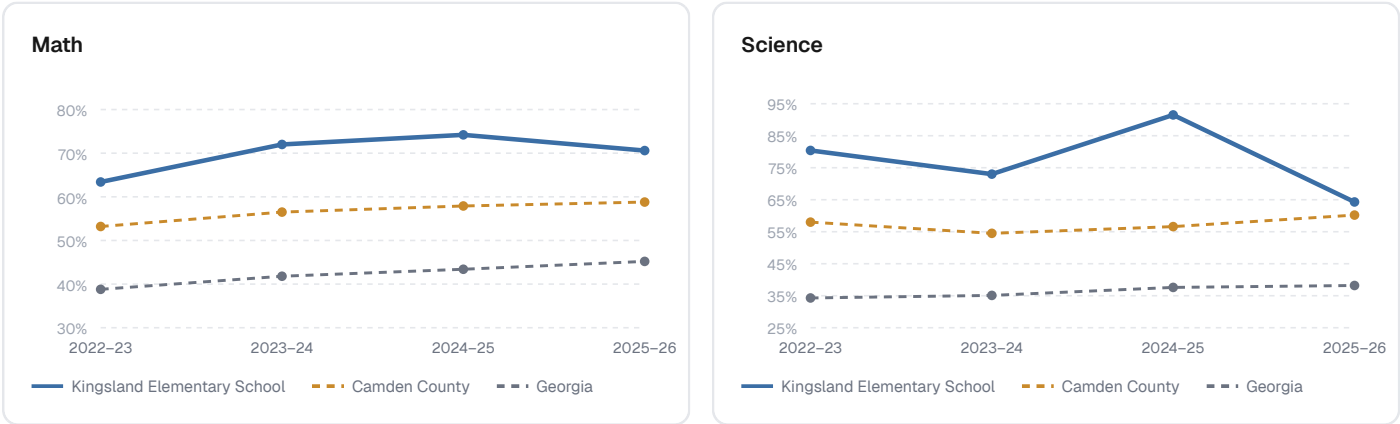
