WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Science lost 14.4 points

67.5% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 81.9% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math widened by 3.0 points

Students with Disabilities sat 45.6 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 48.6 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 4 Math gained 16.7 points

68.1% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 51.4% in 2024–25.

Science is 29.3 points above the state

Mary Lee Clark Elementary School reported 67.5% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Math is 7.8 points above the Camden County average

66.6% here vs. 58.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Math gained 4.6 points

66.6% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 62.0% in 2024–25.

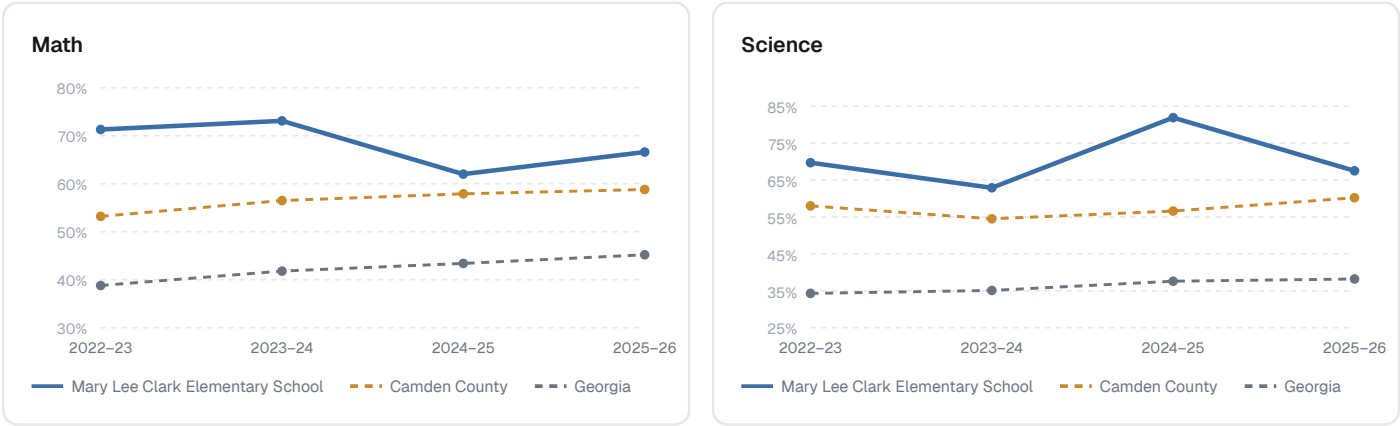
