WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

57.9% → 67.0% → 69.9% → 70.5% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+12.6 pts overall).

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math narrowed by 5.2 points

Students with Disabilities sat 31.6 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 26.4 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 3 Math gained 16.8 points

73.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 56.9% in 2024–25.

Science is 28.1 points above the state

Saint Marys Elementary School reported 66.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Math is 11.7 points above the Camden County average

70.5% here vs. 58.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Grade 4 Math lost 15.8 points

71.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 87.2% in 2024–25.

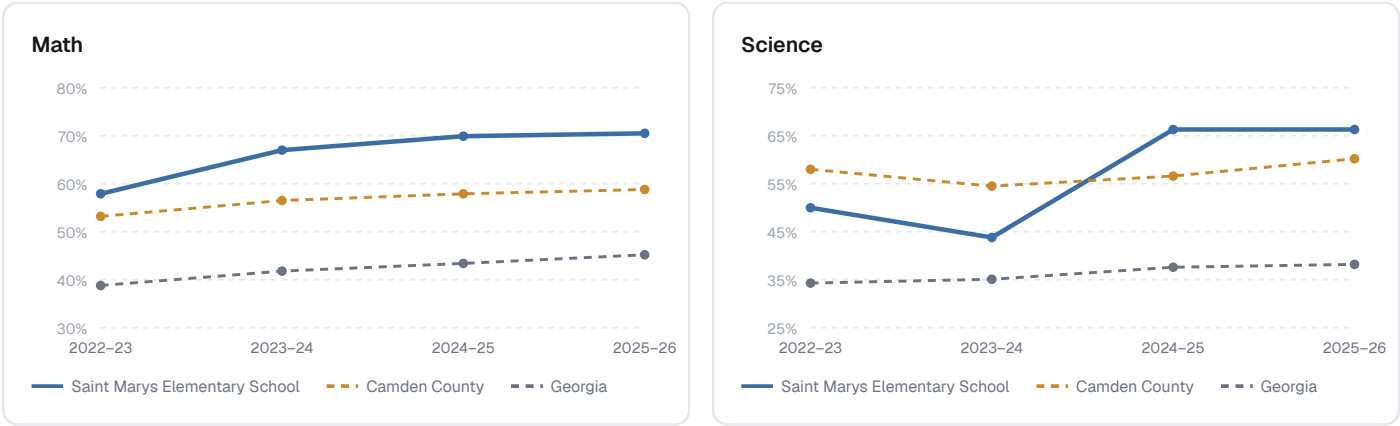
