Findings for 2025–26

Math lost 5.8 points

65.0% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 70.8% in 2024–25.

Grade 4 Math lost 11.4 points

64.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 75.4% in 2024–25.

Science is 40.0 points above the state

Woodbine Elementary School reported 78.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Science is 18.0 points above the Camden County average

78.2% here vs. 60.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Science lost 4.4 points

78.2% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 82.6% in 2024–25.

Grade 5 Math lost 9.2 points

69.1% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 78.3% in 2024–25.

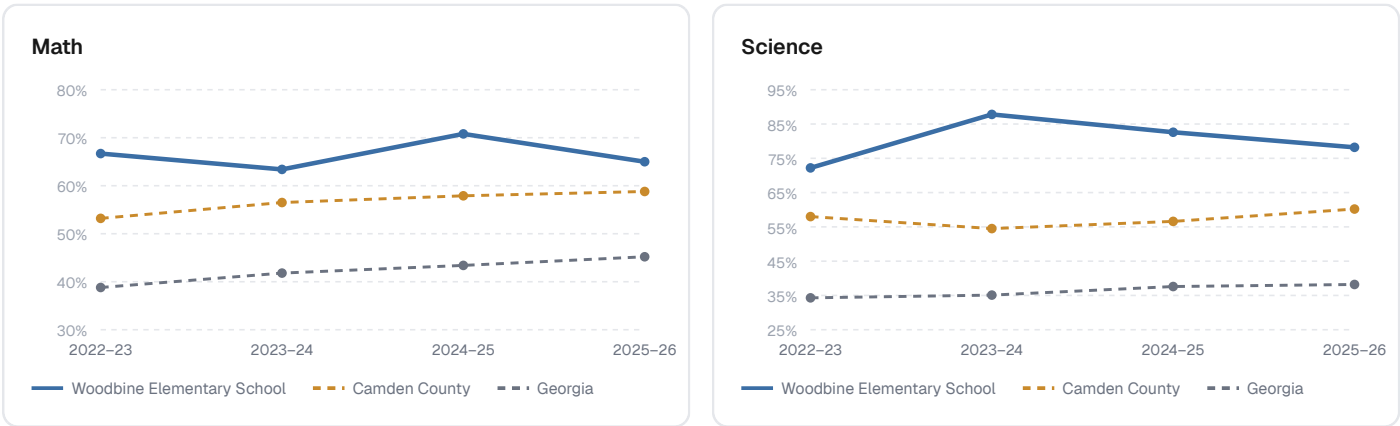
