WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Biology gained 22.5 points

54.6% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 32.1% in 2024–25.

Math has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

38.4% → 39.4% → 39.7% → 42.9% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+4.5 pts overall).

The Students with Disabilities gap in Social Studies narrowed by 16.2 points

Students with Disabilities sat 26.8 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 10.6 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 5 Math lost 18.7 points

31.9% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 50.6% in 2024–25.

Social Studies is 31.1 points below the state

Candler County reported 9.1% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 40.2%.

Social Studies is 30.2 points below the First District average

9.1% here vs. 39.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

English Language Arts results for 2025–26 have not been published yet — GaDOE releases them after standard setting on the revised standards. Every total in this report covers the published subjects only.

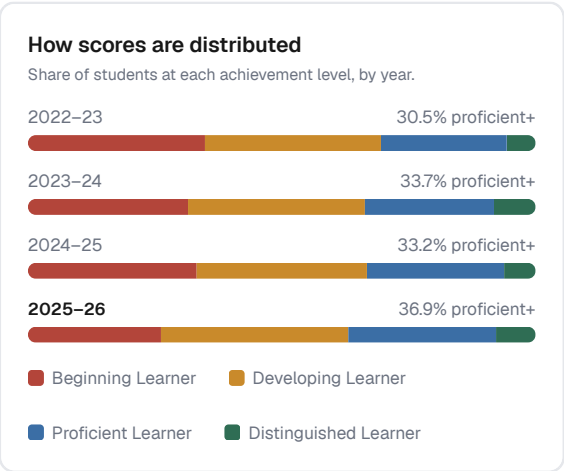
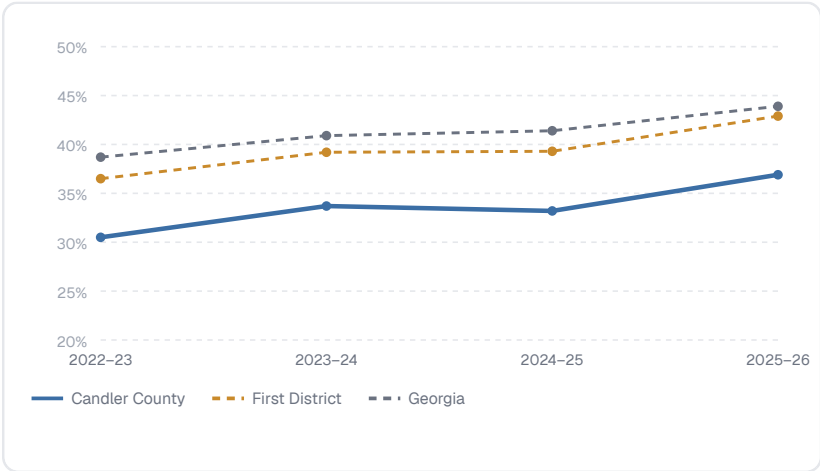

Georgia changed its end-of-course lineup during this period: Algebra I, American Literature and Composition were replaced by Algebra: Concepts and Connections. Year-over-year comparison across that change is not like-for-like.

Cells marked "—" were withheld by the state because the group was too small to report without identifying individual students; they are excluded from averages rather than treated as zero. Where a student group is small, its size is shown beside the percentage and no comparison is drawn — a single student can move such a figure by tens of points, so it should not be read as a trend.
