WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math lost 5.0 points

59.5% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 64.5% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math widened by 10.5 points

Students with Disabilities sat 30.5 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 41.0 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 4 Math lost 18.7 points

57.6% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 76.3% in 2024–25.

Science is 17.0 points above the state

Ebenezer Elementary School reported 55.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Science is 6.4 points above the Effingham County average

55.2% here vs. 48.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Science lost 1.4 points

55.2% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 56.6% in 2024–25.

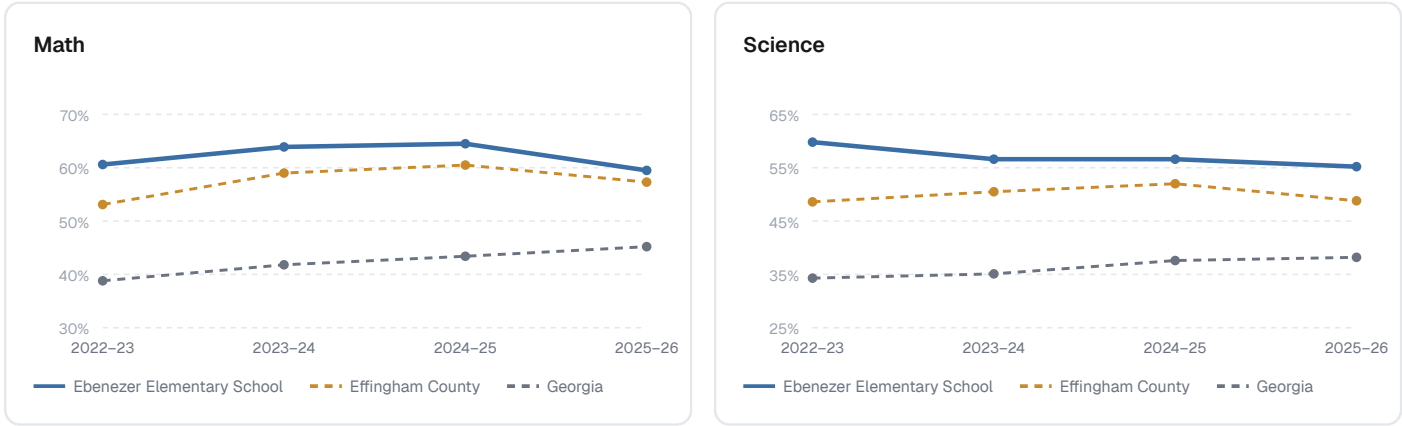
