WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Science gained 16.1 points

71.0% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 54.9% in 2024–25.

Science has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

48.0% → 51.9% → 54.9% → 71.0% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+23.0 pts overall).

Grade 4 Math lost 26.7 points

55.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 82.4% in 2024–25.

Science is 32.8 points above the state

Sand Hill Elementary School reported 71.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Science is 22.2 points above the Effingham County average

71.0% here vs. 48.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Math lost 8.0 points

58.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 66.4% in 2024–25.

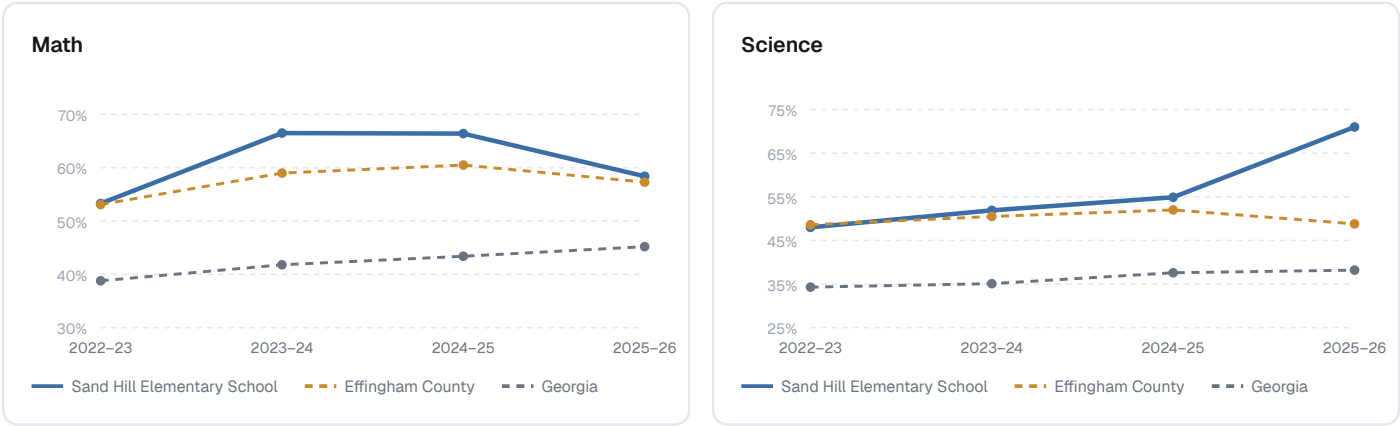
