Findings for 2025–26

Math lost 5.5 points

69.1% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 74.6% in 2024–25.

Grade 4 Math lost 13.3 points

71.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 85.0% in 2024–25.

Science is 31.0 points above the state

South Effingham Elementary School reported 69.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Science is 20.4 points above the Effingham County average

69.2% here vs. 48.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Science lost 1.8 points

69.2% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 71.0% in 2024–25.

Grade 5 Math lost 6.7 points

65.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 71.7% in 2024–25.

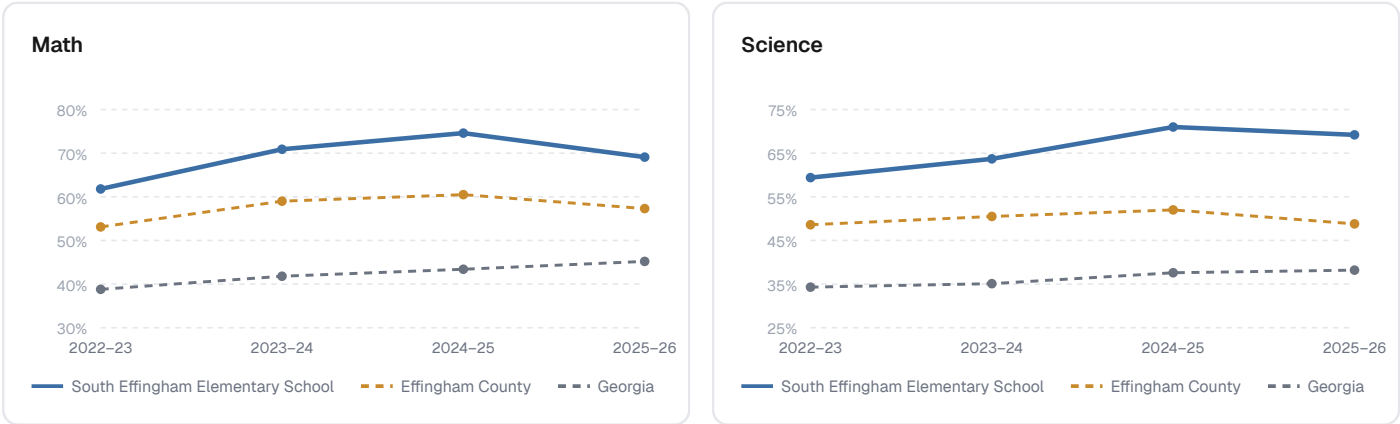
