WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math lost 13.1 points

55.2% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 68.3% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math narrowed by 12.3 points

Students with Disabilities sat 43.2 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 30.9 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 5 Math lost 21.1 points

44.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 65.9% in 2024–25.

Science is 19.6 points above the state

Springfield Elementary School reported 57.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Science is 9.0 points above the Effingham County average

57.8% here vs. 48.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Science lost 7.2 points

57.8% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 65.0% in 2024–25.

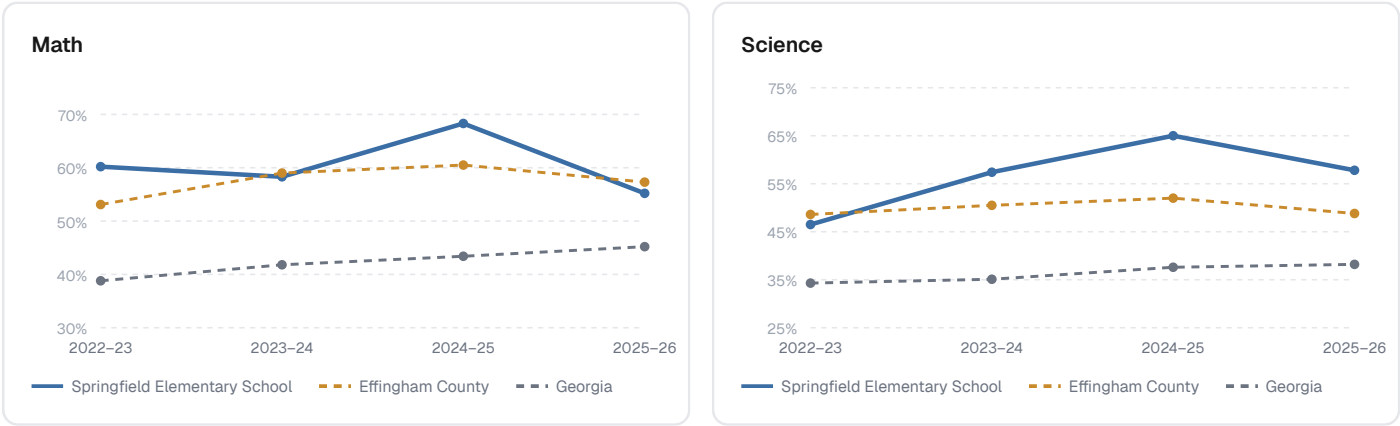
