WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math gained 11.9 points

37.1% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 25.2% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Science narrowed by 14.7 points

Students with Disabilities sat 23.9 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 9.2 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 3 Math gained 16.2 points

50.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 34.6% in 2024–25.

Math is 8.1 points below the state

Swainsboro Elementary School reported 37.1% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Science gained 1.4 points

31.8% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 30.4% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math widened by 9.3 points

Students with Disabilities sat 17.5 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 26.8 points behind them in 2025–26.

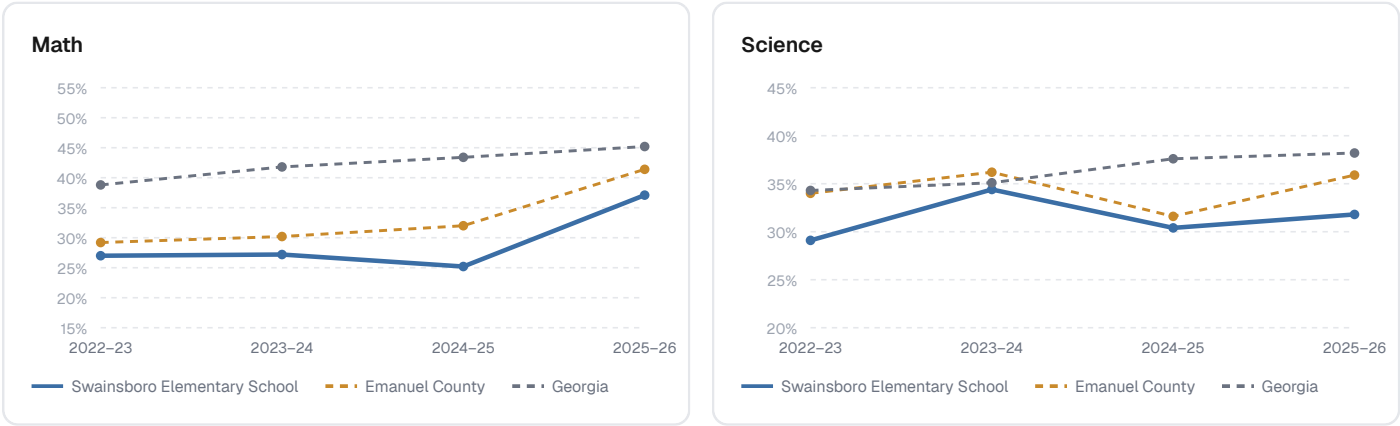
