WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Algebra: C&C gained 11.4 points

16.0% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 4.6% in 2024–25.

Math has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

9.7% → 11.6% → 12.2% → 21.9% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+12.2 pts overall).

The Students with Disabilities gap in Science widened by 14.1 points

Students with Disabilities sat 8.6 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 22.7 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 8 Math gained 26.4 points

32.9% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 6.5% in 2024–25.

Biology is 35.1 points below the state

Evans County reported 12.1% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 47.2%.

Biology is 36.8 points below the First District average

12.1% here vs. 48.9% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

English Language Arts results for 2025–26 have not been published yet — GaDOE releases them after standard setting on the revised standards. Every total in this report covers the published subjects only.

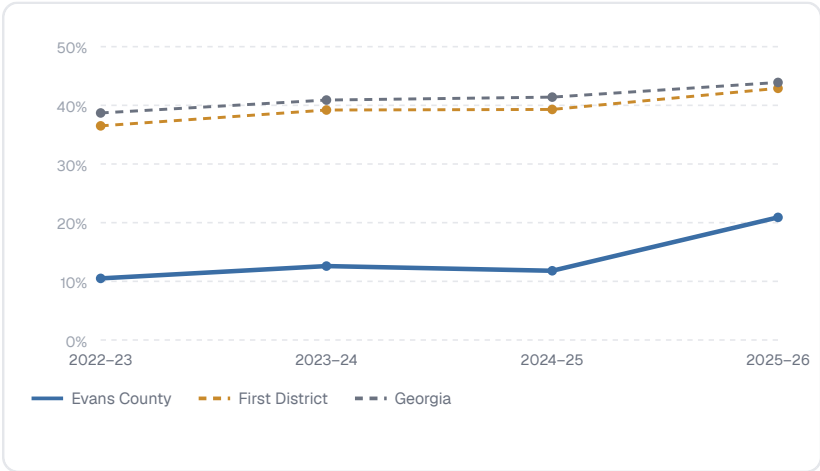

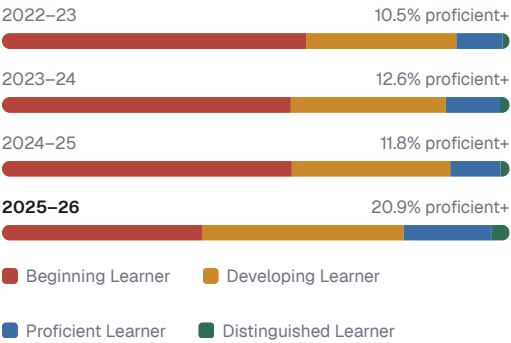
Trend against the region and the state

Georgia changed its end-of-course lineup during this period: Algebra I, American Literature and Composition were replaced by Algebra: Concepts and Connections. Year-over-year comparison across that change is not like-for-like.

"Proficient or Distinguished" combines the top two of Georgia's four achievement levels and is the measure used for grade-level readiness. Cells marked "—" were withheld by the state because the group was too small to report without identifying individual students; they are excluded from averages rather than treated as zero. Where a student group is small, its size is shown beside the percentage and no comparison is drawn — a single student can move such a figure by tens of points, so it should not be read as a trend.
