WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math gained 15.8 points

22.6% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 6.8% in 2024–25.

The Limited English Proficient gap in Math widened by 10.8 points

Limited English Proficient sat 7.9 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 18.7 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 8 Math gained 27.8 points

35.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 7.5% in 2024–25.

Social Studies is 25.4 points below the state

Claxton Middle School reported 14.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 40.2%.

Science gained 11.6 points

19.2% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 7.6% in 2024–25.

Grade 6 Math gained 13.0 points

18.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 5.0% in 2024–25.
