Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Science gained 8.0 points

29.1% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 21.1% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math widened by 3.7 points

Students with Disabilities sat 30.1 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 33.8 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 5 Math gained 12.3 points

35.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 23.1% in 2024–25.

Science is 9.1 points below the state

Altama Elementary School reported 29.1% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Science is 15.2 points below the Glynn County average

29.1% here vs. 44.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Math gained 4.7 points

36.6% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 31.9% in 2024–25.

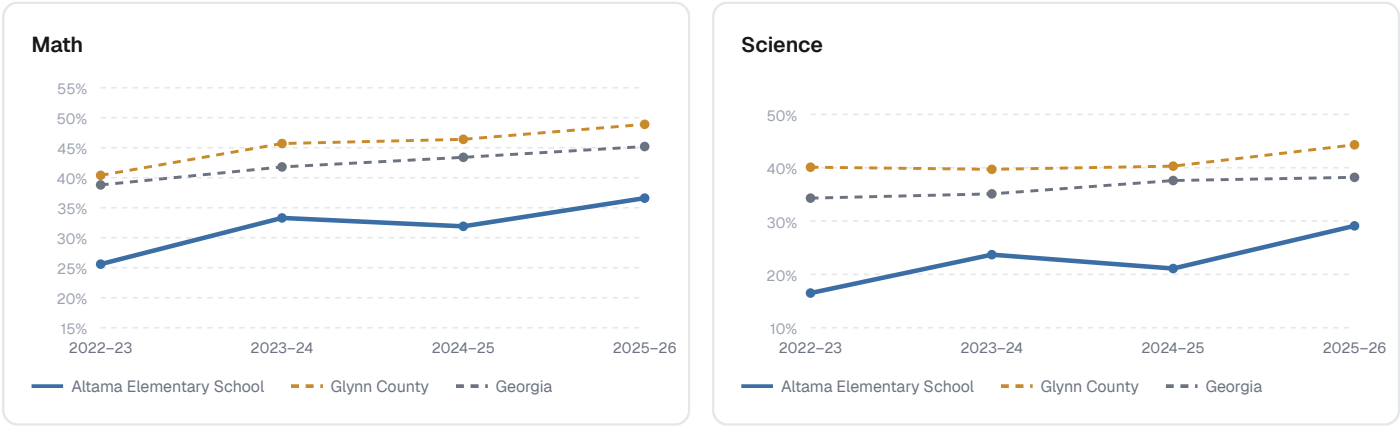
