WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math lost 4.3 points

19.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 23.7% in 2024–25.

Math has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

34.3% → 24.1% → 23.7% → 19.4% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (–14.9 pts overall).

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math narrowed by 6.7 points

Students with Disabilities sat 25.0 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 18.3 points behind them in 2025–26.

Math is 25.8 points below the state

Burroughs-Molette Elementary School reported 19.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Math is 29.5 points below the Glynn County average

19.4% here vs. 48.9% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Science gained 3.6 points

27.8% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 24.2% in 2024–25.

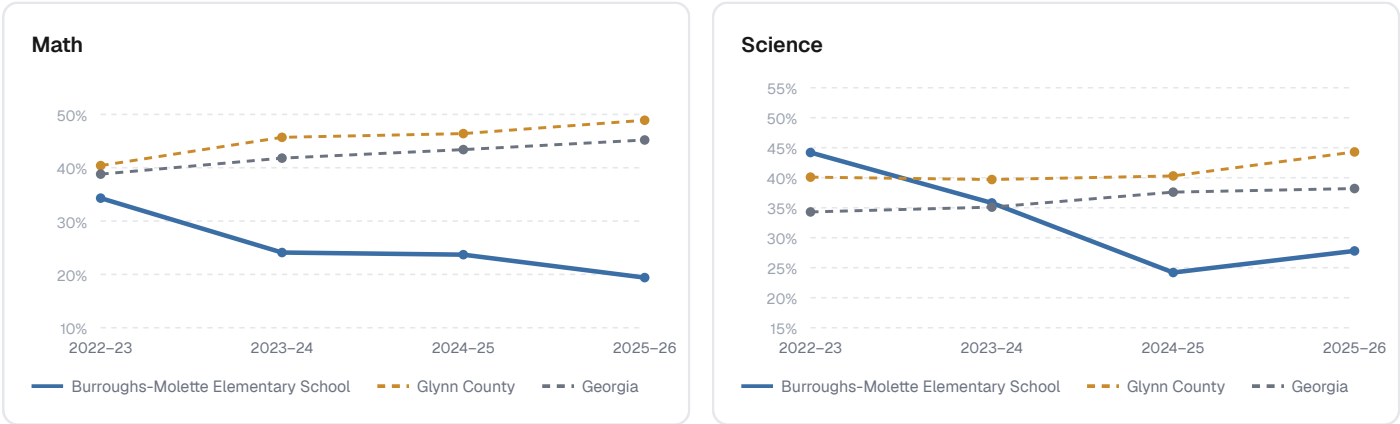
