Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math gained 8.7 points

39.8% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 31.1% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Science narrowed by 18.9 points

Students with Disabilities sat 38.3 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 19.4 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 4 Math gained 16.0 points

48.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 32.2% in 2024–25.

Math is 5.4 points below the state

Glyndale Elementary School reported 39.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Math is 9.1 points below the Glynn County average

39.8% here vs. 48.9% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Science gained 2.8 points

40.2% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 37.4% in 2024–25.

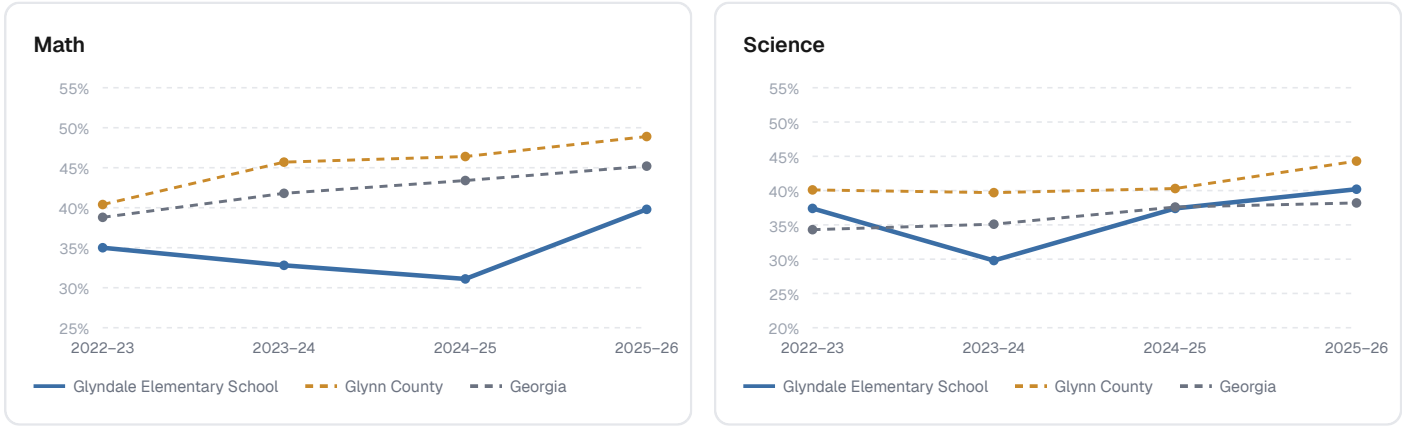
