WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Social Studies gained 19.3 points

61.0% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 41.7% in 2024–25.

The Limited English Proficient gap in Math widened by 5.6 points

Limited English Proficient sat 40.3 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 45.9 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 8 Social Studies gained 19.3 points

61.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 41.7% in 2024–25.

Algebra: C&C is 51.9 points above the state

Glynn Middle reported 100.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 48.1%.

Algebra: C&C is 43.0 points above the Glynn County average

100.0% here vs. 57.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Math gained 6.7 points

54.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 47.7% in 2024–25.

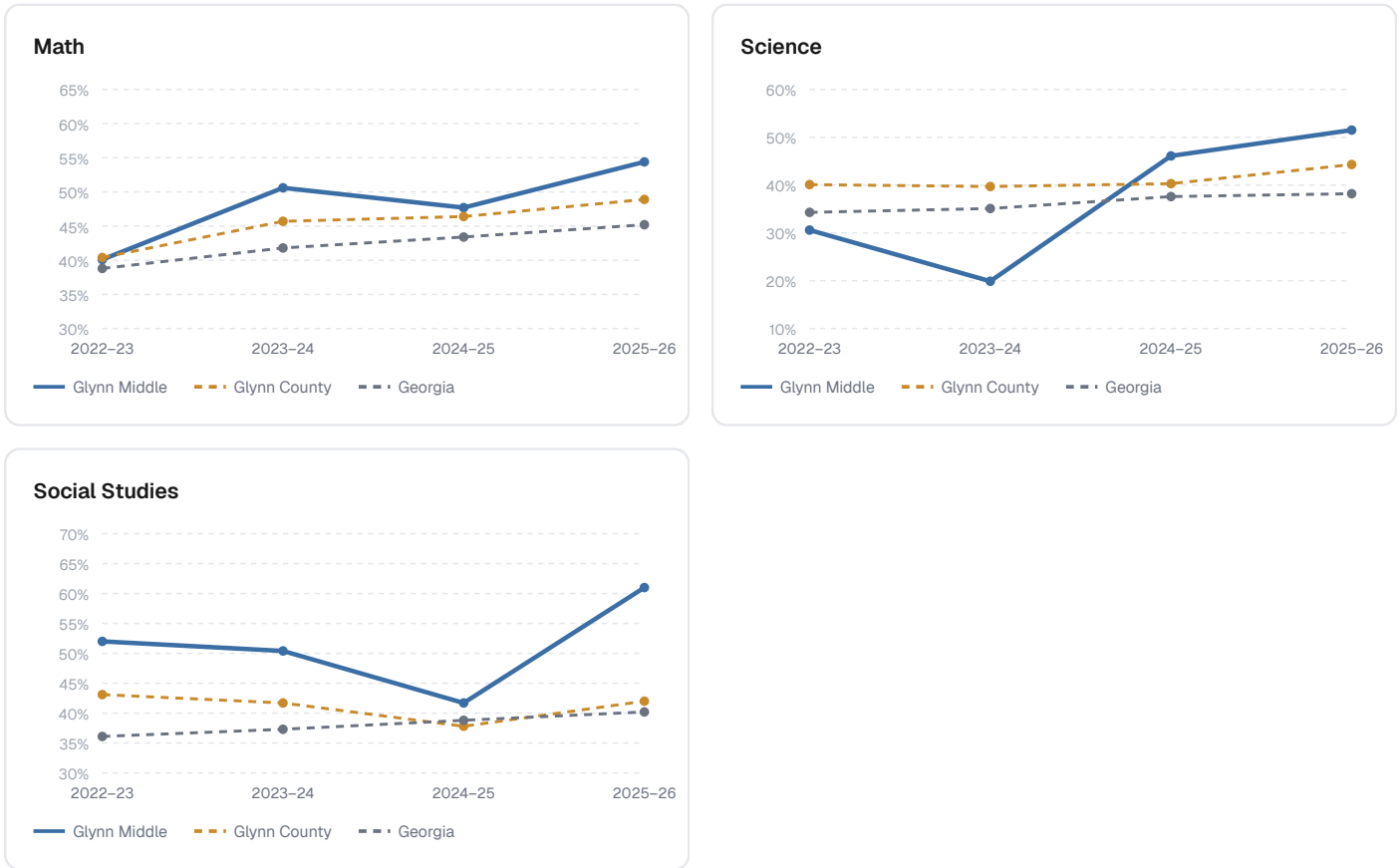
