Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Science lost 6.3 points

44.6% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 50.9% in 2024–25.

The Limited English Proficient gap in Math narrowed by 14.6 points

Limited English Proficient sat 34.9 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 20.3 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 3 Math gained 6.4 points

41.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 34.9% in 2024–25.

Science is 6.4 points above the state

Golden Isles Elementary School reported 44.6% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Grade 5 Science lost 6.3 points

44.6% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 50.9% in 2024–25.

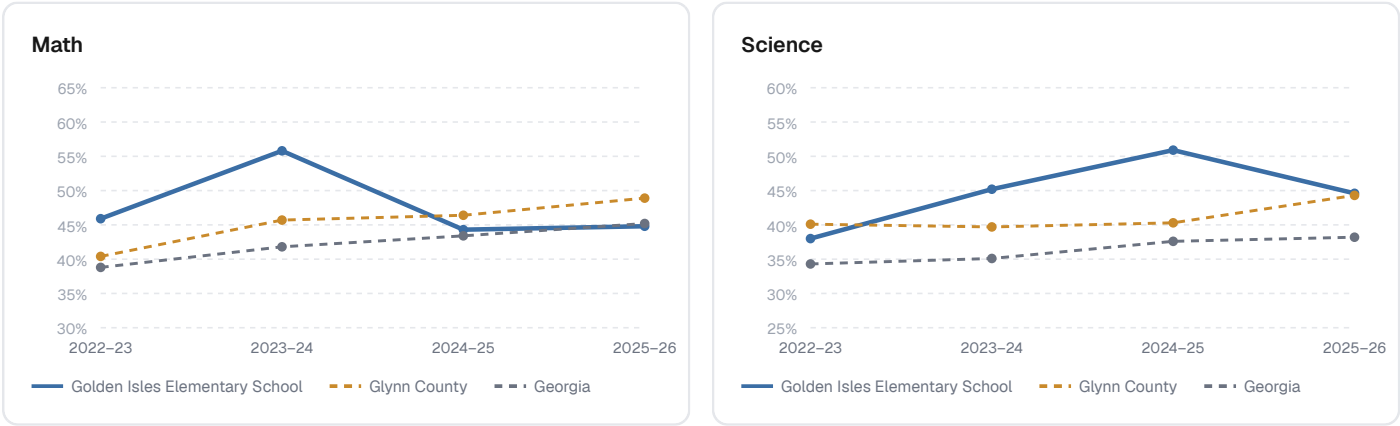
