WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math narrowed by 5.0 points

Students with Disabilities sat 50.1 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 45.1 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 4 Math gained 11.3 points

70.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 59.5% in 2024–25.

Science is 21.3 points above the state

Greer Elementary School reported 59.5% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Science is 15.2 points above the Glynn County average

59.5% here vs. 44.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

The Limited English Proficient gap in Math widened by 3.5 points

Limited English Proficient sat 42.7 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 46.2 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 3 Math lost 6.3 points

51.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 57.6% in 2024–25.

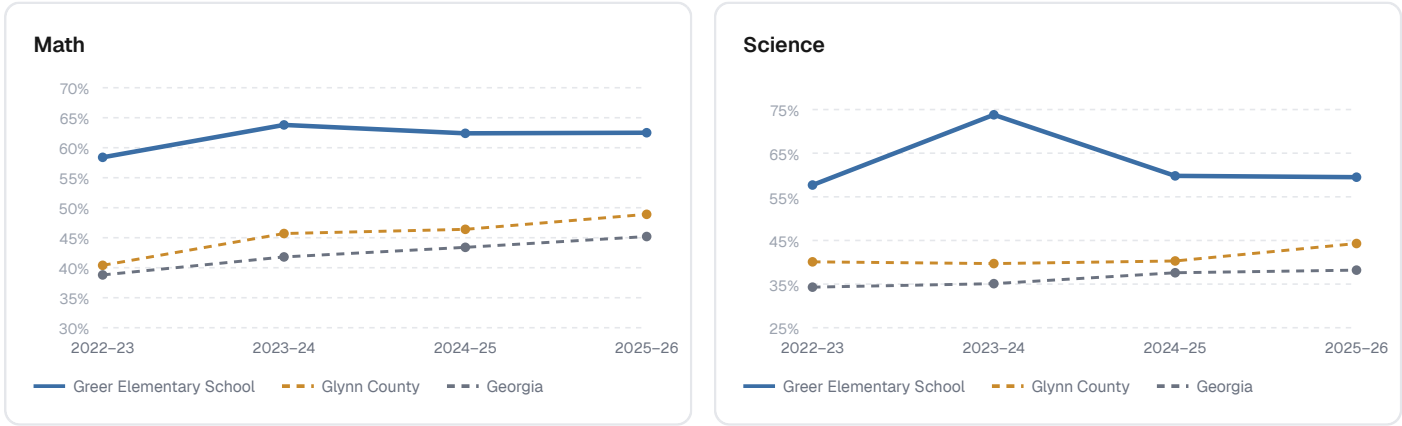
