WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Science gained 4.9 points

44.3% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 39.4% in 2024–25.

Math has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

32.2% → 40.1% → 47.4% → 48.0% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+15.8 pts overall).

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math narrowed by 11.8 points

Students with Disabilities sat 39.7 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 27.9 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 7 Math gained 6.2 points

45.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 38.8% in 2024–25.

Algebra: C&C is 51.9 points above the state

Needwood Middle School reported 100.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 48.1%.

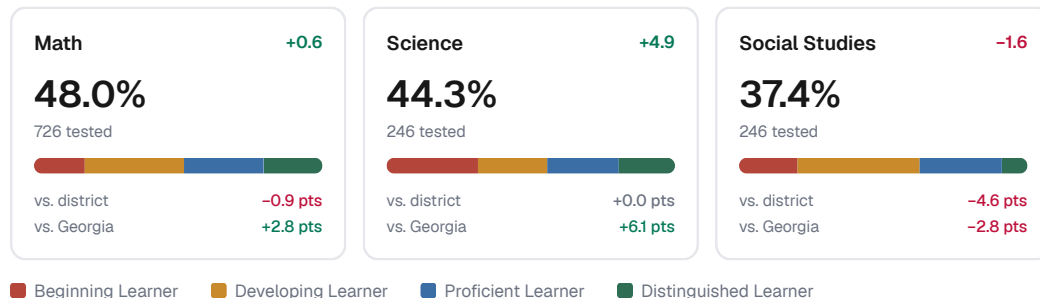
Algebra: C&C is 43.0 points above the Glynn County average
