Findings for 2025–26

Math gained 8.4 points

75.2% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 66.8% in 2024–25.

Grade 3 Math gained 20.1 points

87.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 67.1% in 2024–25.

Math is 30.0 points above the state

St. Simons Elementary School reported 75.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Math is 26.3 points above the Glynn County average

Science lost 7.8 points

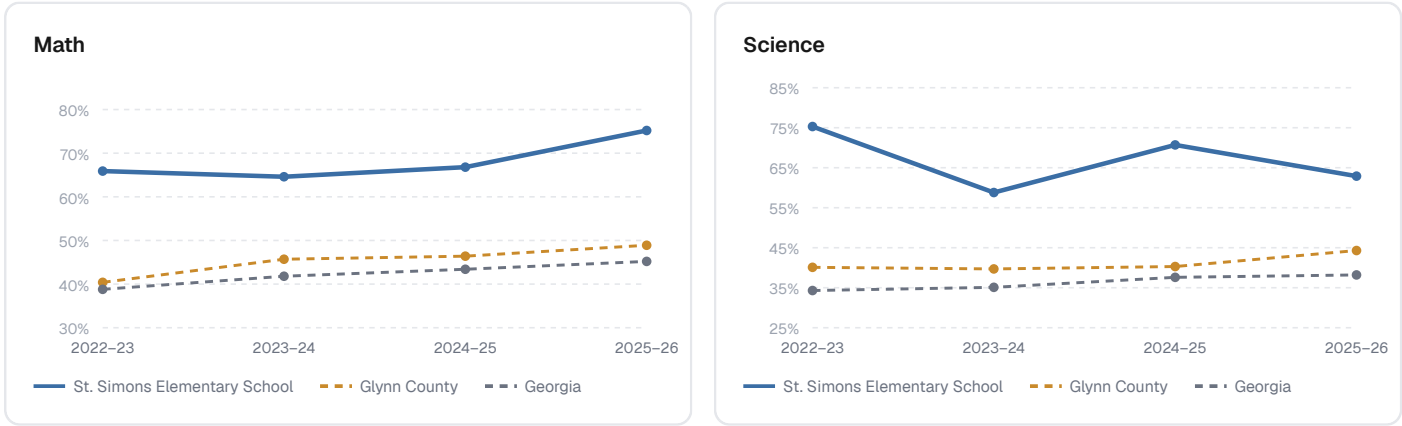
