WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Biology gained 11.7 points

55.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 43.7% in 2024–25.

The Limited English Proficient gap in Science narrowed by 7.6 points

Limited English Proficient sat 32.1 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 24.5 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 8 Science lost 6.5 points

36.6% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 43.1% in 2024–25.

Social Studies is 16.4 points above the state

Jeff Davis County reported 56.6% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 40.2%.

Social Studies is 17.3 points above the First District average

56.6% here vs. 39.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Algebra: C&C gained 6.7 points

47.6% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 40.9% in 2024–25.

English Language Arts results for 2025–26 have not been published yet — GaDOE releases them after standard setting on the revised standards. Every total in this report covers the published subjects only.

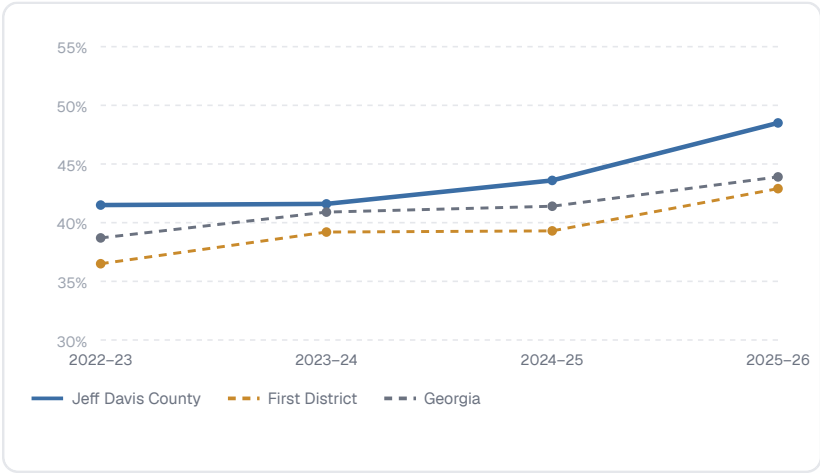

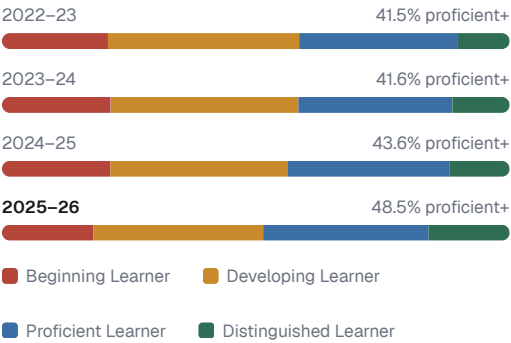

Georgia changed its end-of-course lineup during this period: Algebra I, American Literature and Composition were replaced by Algebra: Concepts and Connections. Year-over-year comparison across that change is not like-for-like.

Source: Georgia Milestones district aggregates published by the Governor's Office of Student Achievement. "Proficient or Distinguished" combines the top two of Georgia's four achievement levels and is the measure used for grade-level readiness. Cells marked "—" were withheld by the state because the group was too small to report without identifying individual students; they are excluded from averages rather than treated as zero. Where a student group is small, its size is shown beside the percentage and no comparison is drawn — a single student can move such a figure by tens of points, so it should not be read as a trend.
