WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math lost 1.3 points

49.8% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 51.1% in 2024–25.

Science has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

30.2% → 34.3% → 36.2% → 36.7% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+6.5 pts overall).

The Students with Disabilities gap in Science narrowed by 7.3 points

Students with Disabilities sat 29.4 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 22.1 points behind them in 2025–26.

Math is 4.6 points above the state

Jeff Davis Elementary School reported 49.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math narrowed by 6.0 points

Students with Disabilities sat 34.1 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 28.1 points behind them in 2025–26.

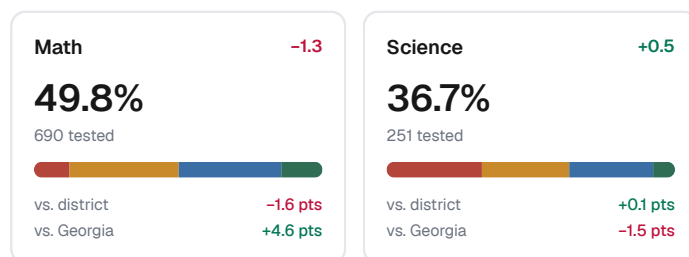
The Limited English Proficient gap in Math narrowed by 3.5 points

Limited English Proficient sat 19.8 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 16.3 points behind them in 2025–26.

Percent of students scoring Proficient or Distinguished, with the change from last year and the distance to the district and state averages.

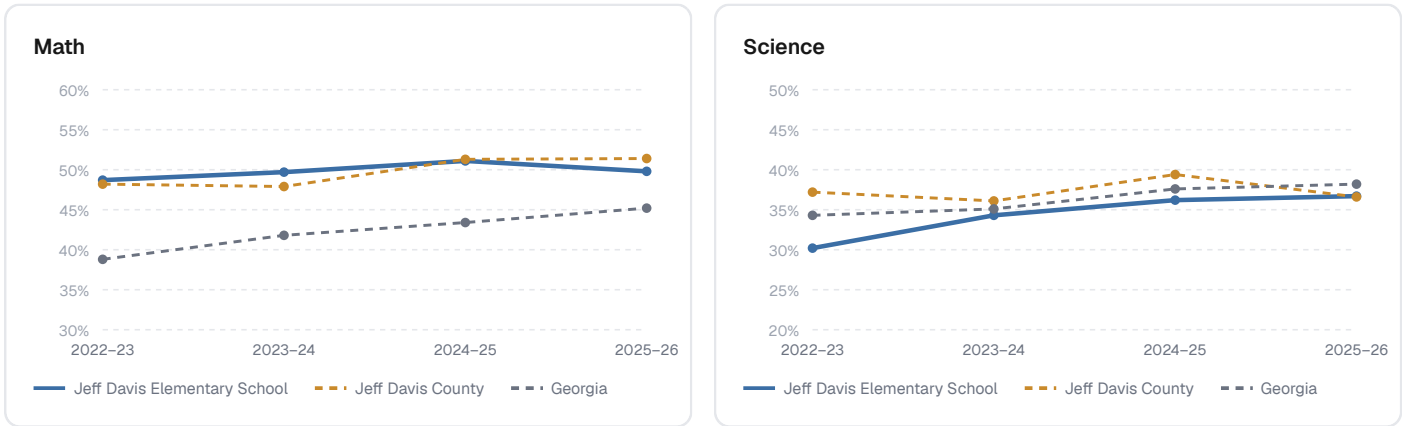


■ Beginning Learner
