Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math gained 7.4 points

33.0% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 25.6% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math narrowed by 14.4 points

Students with Disabilities sat 23.6 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 9.2 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 4 Math gained 16.1 points

33.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 17.6% in 2024–25.

Math is 12.2 points below the state

Button Gwinnett Elementary School reported 33.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Grade 3 Math gained 10.5 points

41.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 31.3% in 2024–25.

Science is 5.7 points below the state

Button Gwinnett Elementary School reported 32.5% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

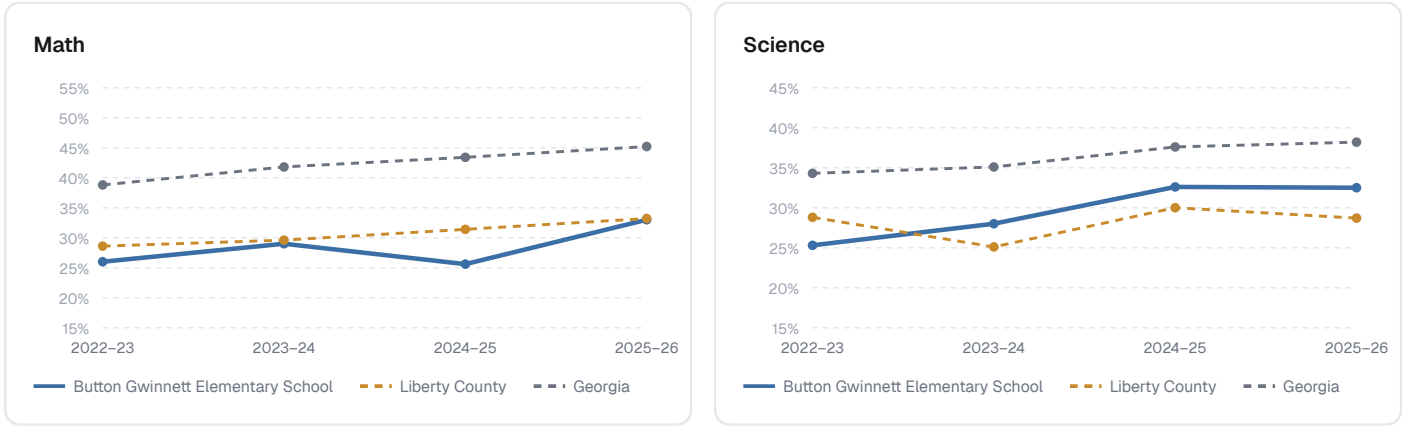
