WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Science lost 6.1 points

33.0% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 39.1% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math narrowed by 9.8 points

Students with Disabilities sat 31.3 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 21.5 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 4 Math lost 17.5 points

30.1% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 47.6% in 2024–25.

Math is 9.7 points below the state

Frank Long Elementary School reported 35.5% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Math lost 3.2 points

35.5% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 38.7% in 2024–25.

Grade 3 Math gained 11.3 points

48.6% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 37.3% in 2024–25.

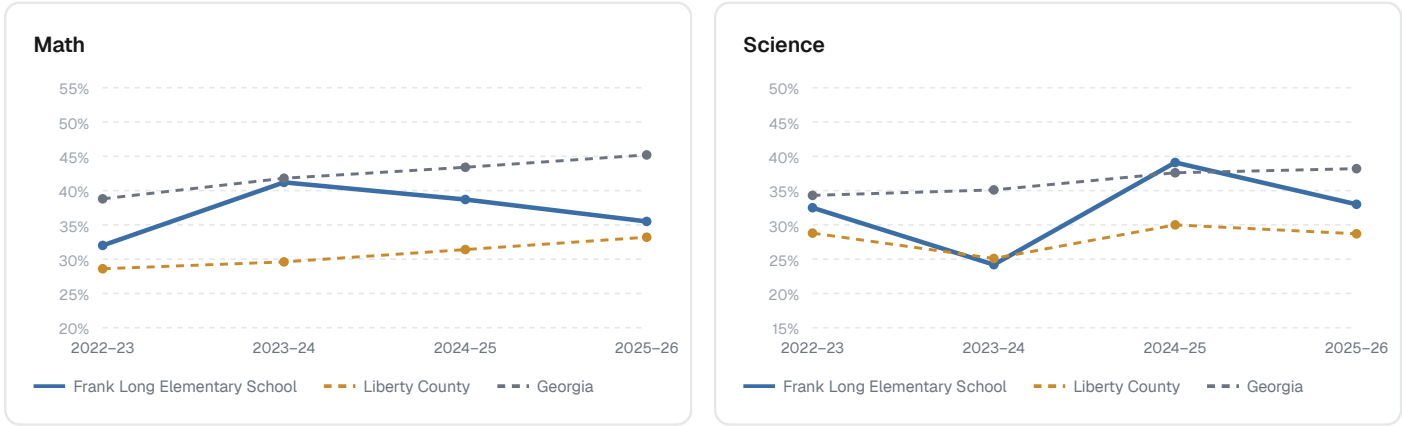
