WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Algebra: C&C gained 4.7 points

92.3% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 87.6% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Social Studies narrowed by 14.6 points

Students with Disabilities sat 36.9 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 22.3 points behind them in 2025–26.

Algebra: C&C is 44.2 points above the state

Lewis Frasier Middle School reported 92.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 48.1%.

Algebra: C&C is 63.1 points above the Liberty County average

92.3% here vs. 29.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Science lost 3.8 points

20.0% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 23.8% in 2024–25.

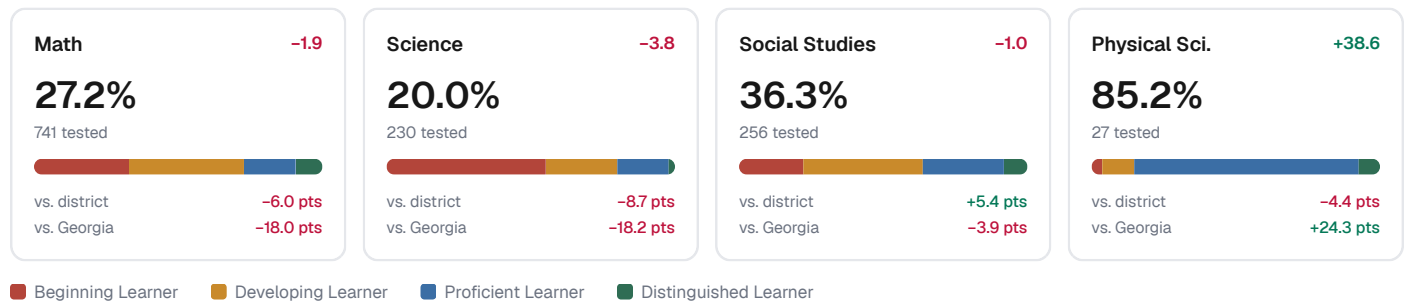
The Students with Disabilities gap in Science narrowed by 4.4 points

Students with Disabilities sat 24.6 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 20.2 points behind them in 2025–26.
