Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Science gained 9.3 points

27.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 18.1% in 2024–25.

Math has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

24.8% → 23.9% → 23.0% → 18.7% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (–6.1 pts overall).

Grade 4 Math lost 9.6 points

16.5% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 26.1% in 2024–25.

Math is 26.5 points below the state

Lyman Hall Elementary School reported 18.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Math is 14.5 points below the Liberty County average

18.7% here vs. 33.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Math lost 4.3 points

18.7% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 23.0% in 2024–25.

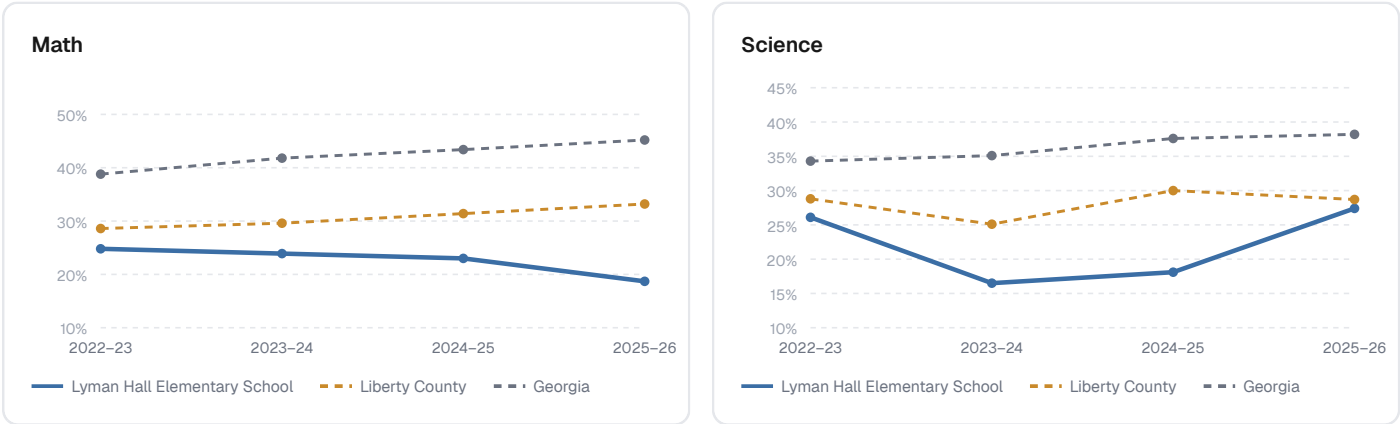
