WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Algebra: C&C gained 30.9 points

94.5% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 63.6% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Social Studies widened by 3.1 points

Students with Disabilities sat 21.4 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 24.5 points behind them in 2025–26.

Algebra: C&C is 46.4 points above the state

Snelson-Golden Middle School reported 94.5% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 48.1%.

Algebra: C&C is 65.3 points above the Liberty County average

94.5% here vs. 29.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Science gained 5.4 points

22.5% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 17.1% in 2024–25.

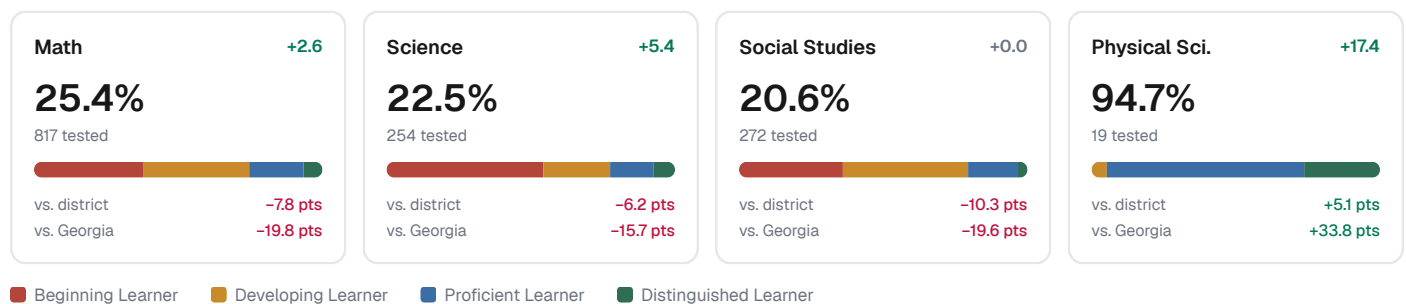
Math is 19.8 points below the state

Snelson-Golden Middle School reported 25.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Performance by subject

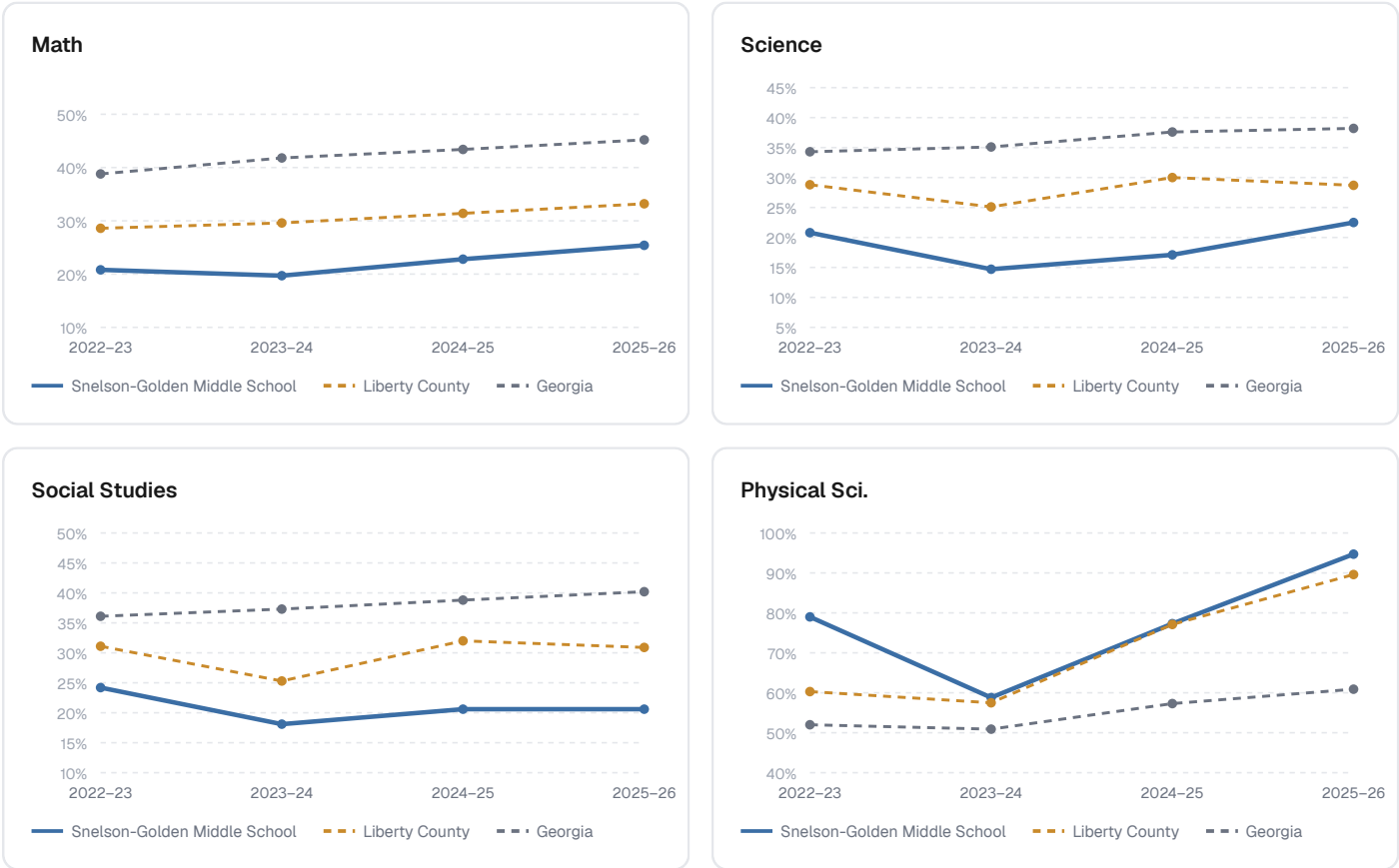
Percent of students scoring Proficient or Distinguished, with the change from last year and the distance to the district and state averages.
