Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math gained 5.2 points

31.5% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 26.3% in 2024–25.

Grade 4 Math gained 9.5 points

34.1% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 24.6% in 2024–25.

Math is 13.7 points below the state

Waldo Pafford Elementary School reported 31.5% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Science is 6.7 points above the Liberty County average

35.4% here vs. 28.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Science lost 4.6 points

35.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 40.0% in 2024–25.

Grade 3 Math gained 9.2 points

37.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 28.2% in 2024–25.

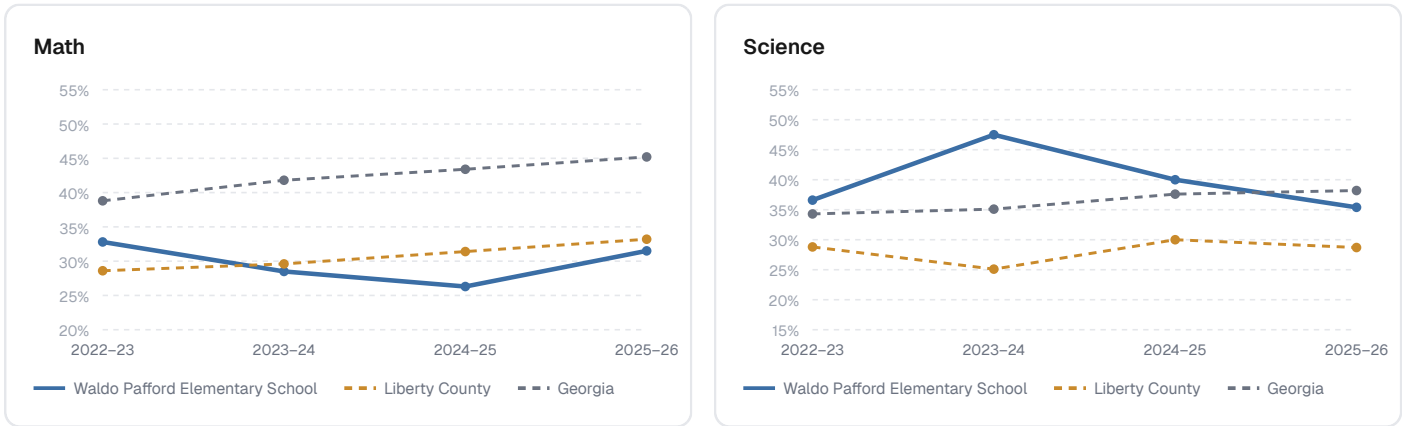
