WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Biology gained 7.2 points

51.3% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 44.1% in 2024–25.

Science has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

27.6% → 28.2% → 37.2% → 39.2% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+11.6 pts overall).

The Students with Disabilities gap in US History widened by 12.8 points

Students with Disabilities sat 28.4 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 41.2 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 4 Math gained 12.7 points

41.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 28.3% in 2024–25.

US History is 14.0 points above the state

Long County reported 52.5% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.5%.

Math is 9.2 points below the First District average

34.8% here vs. 44.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

English Language Arts results for 2025–26 have not been published yet — GaDOE releases them after standard setting on the revised standards. Every total in this report covers the published subjects only.

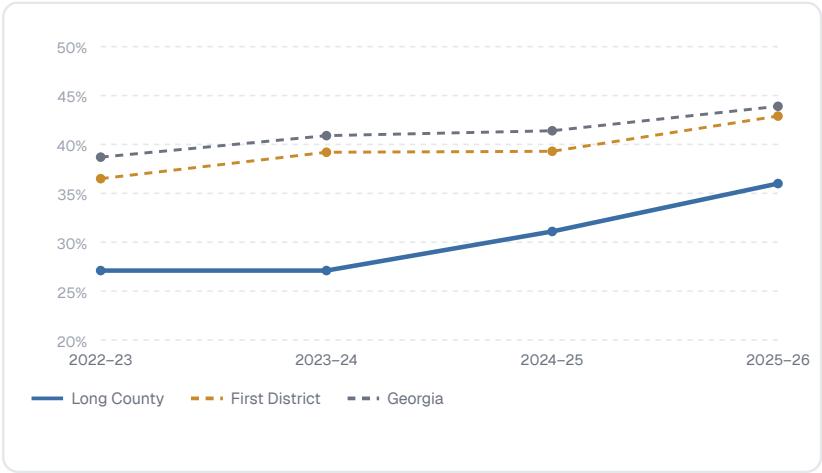

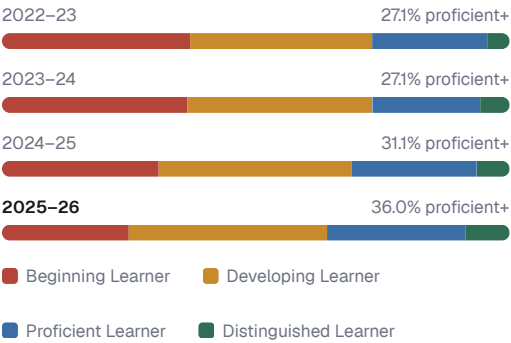
Trend against the region and the state

"Proficient or Distinguished" combines the top two of Georgia's four achievement levels and is the measure used for grade-level readiness. Cells marked "—" were withheld by the state because the group was too small to report without identifying individual students; they are excluded from averages rather than treated as zero. Where a student group is small, its size is shown beside the percentage and no comparison is drawn — a single student can move such a figure by tens of points, so it should not be read as a trend.
