WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Algebra: C&C gained 9.0 points

90.3% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 81.3% in 2024–25.

Science has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

22.7% → 29.9% → 31.8% → 35.7% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+13.0 pts overall).

The Students with Disabilities gap in Social Studies widened by 12.2 points

Students with Disabilities sat 19.4 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 31.6 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 6 Math gained 10.8 points

30.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 20.0% in 2024–25.

Algebra: C&C is 42.2 points above the state

Long County Middle School reported 90.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 48.1%.

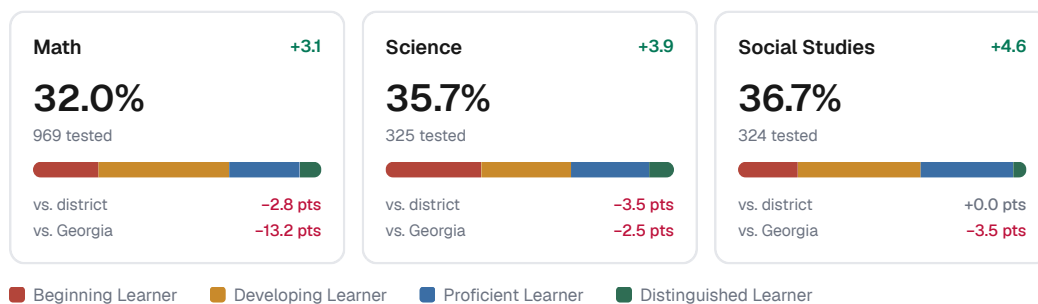
Algebra: C&C is 35.3 points above the Long County average

Performance by subject

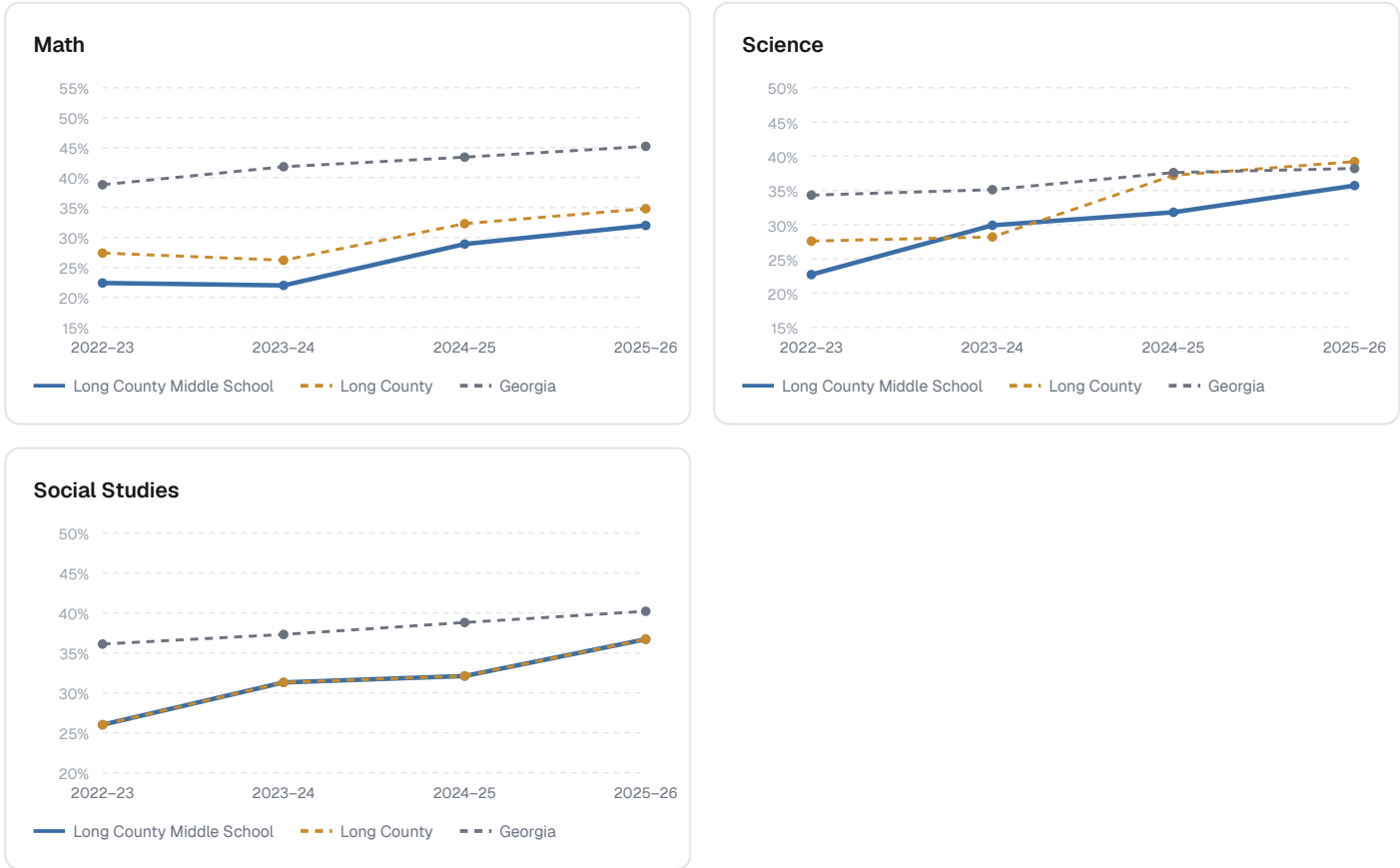
Percent of students scoring Proficient or Distinguished, with the change from last year and the distance to the district and state averages.
