Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math gained 8.4 points

35.8% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 27.4% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math narrowed by 10.9 points

Students with Disabilities sat 19.6 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 8.7 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 7 Math gained 20.1 points

34.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 14.3% in 2024–25.

Science is 15.7 points below the state

McIntosh County Middle School reported 22.5% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Social Studies lost 2.9 points

27.5% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 30.4% in 2024–25.

Grade 6 Math gained 14.6 points

51.5% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 36.9% in 2024–25.

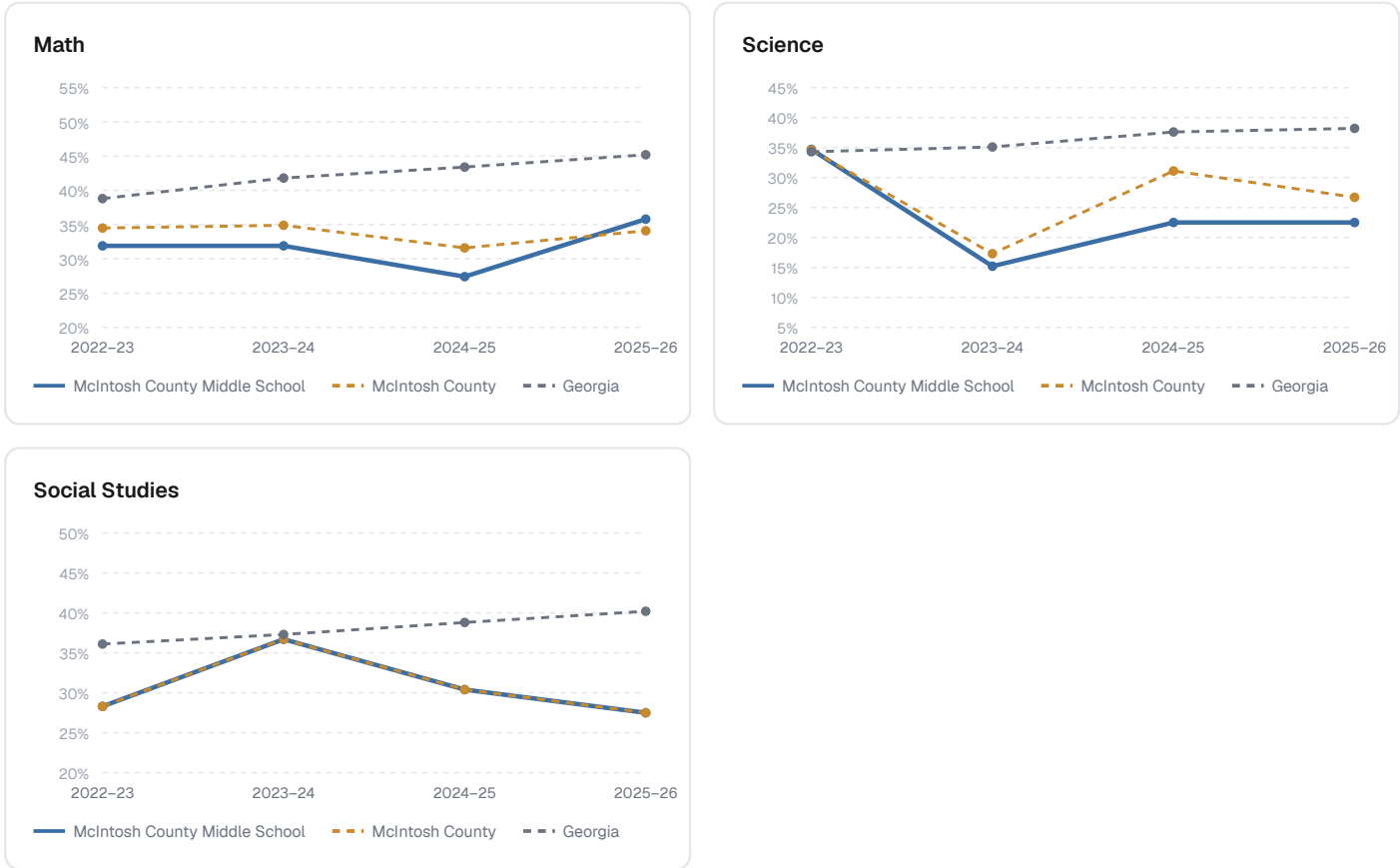
