WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Social Studies gained 5.5 points

26.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 20.9% in 2024–25.

Math has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

25.6% → 28.7% → 29.7% → 33.0% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+7.4 pts overall).

The Limited English Proficient gap in Social Studies widened by 7.1 points

Limited English Proficient sat 18.3 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 25.4 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 6 Math gained 6.4 points

25.9% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 19.5% in 2024–25.

Algebra: C&C is 15.3 points below the state

Savannah-Chatham County reported 32.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 48.1%.

Algebra: C&C is 14.2 points below the First District average

32.8% here vs. 47.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

English Language Arts results for 2025–26 have not been published yet — GaDOE releases them after standard setting on the revised standards. Every total in this report covers the published subjects only.

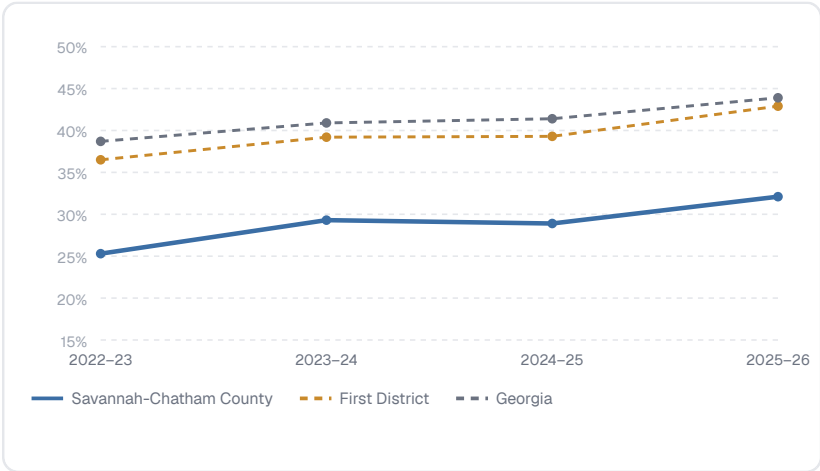

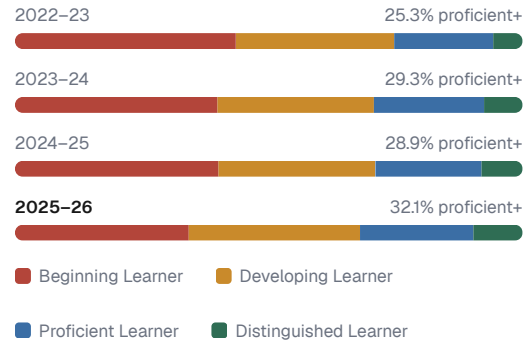

Georgia changed its end-of-course lineup during this period: Algebra I, American Literature and Composition were replaced by Algebra: Concepts and Connections. Year-over-year comparison across that change is not like-for-like.

"Proficient or Distinguished" combines the top two of Georgia's four achievement levels and is the measure used for grade-level readiness. Cells marked "—" were withheld by the state because the group was too small to report without identifying individual students; they are excluded from averages rather than treated as zero. Where a student group is small, its size is shown beside the percentage and no comparison is drawn — a single student can move such a figure by tens of points, so it should not be read as a trend.
