Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math gained 5.1 points

37.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 32.3% in 2024–25.

The Students with Disabilities gap in Math widened by 16.9 points

Students with Disabilities sat 15.0 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 31.9 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 4 Math gained 11.5 points

41.5% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 30.0% in 2024–25.

Math is 7.8 points below the state

Bloomington Elementary School reported 37.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Science is 9.6 points above the Savannah-Chatham County average

39.5% here vs. 29.9% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Grade 5 Math gained 6.2 points

39.6% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 33.4% in 2024–25.

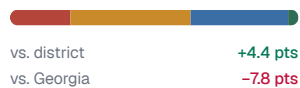

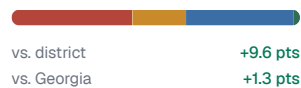

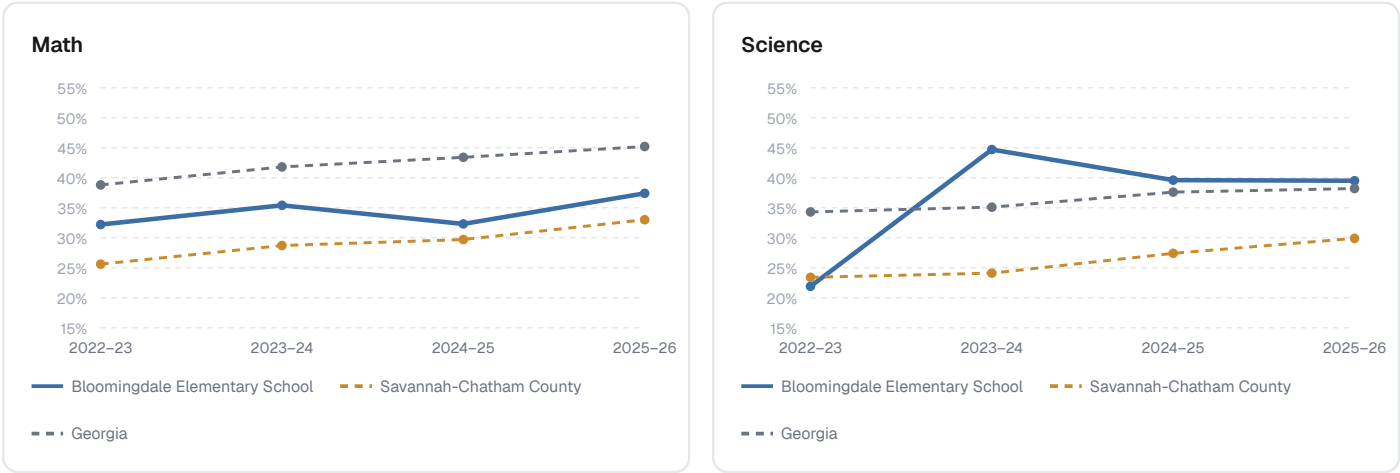
