WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Math gained 15.1 points

35.7% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 20.6% in 2024–25.

The Limited English Proficient gap in Math widened by 12.6 points

Limited English Proficient sat 11.8 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 24.4 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 5 Math gained 21.4 points

37.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 16.4% in 2024–25.

Math is 9.5 points below the state

Butler Elementary School reported 35.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 45.2%.

Science gained 10.9 points

31.8% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 20.9% in 2024–25.

Grade 3 Math gained 14.9 points

32.9% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 18.0% in 2024–25.

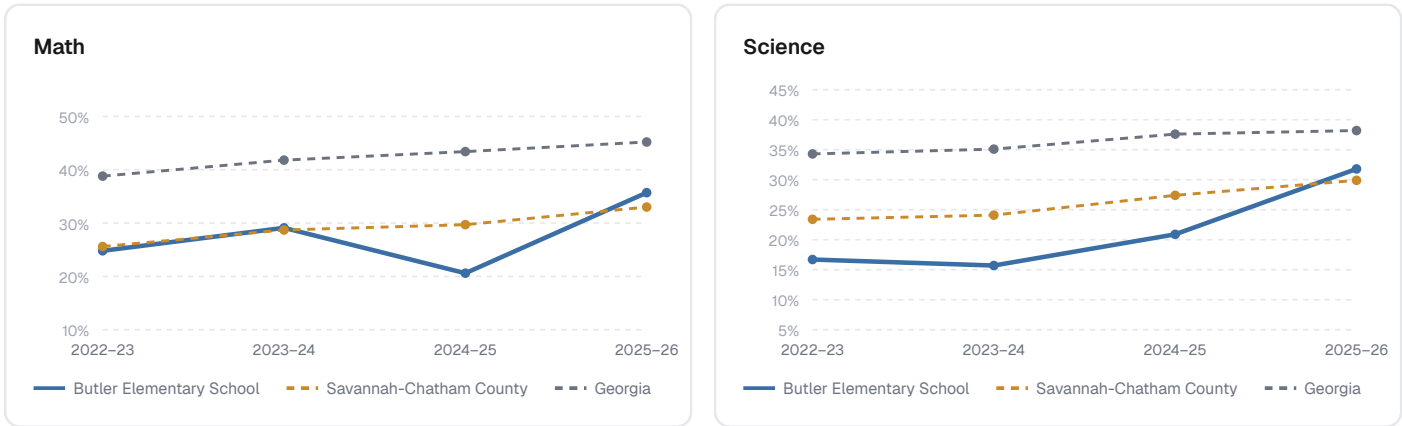
