WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Social Studies gained 7.2 points

56.3% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 49.1% in 2024–25.

Social Studies has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

40.0% → 46.5% → 49.1% → 56.3% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+16.3 pts overall).

The Students with Disabilities gap in Science widened by 19.0 points

Students with Disabilities sat 28.1 points behind Students without Disabilities in 2024–25, and 47.1 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 6 Math gained 11.5 points

53.3% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 41.8% in 2024–25.

Algebra: C&C is 50.1 points above the state

Coastal Middle School reported 98.2% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 48.1%.

Algebra: C&C is 65.4 points above the Savannah-Chatham County average

98.2% here vs. 32.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

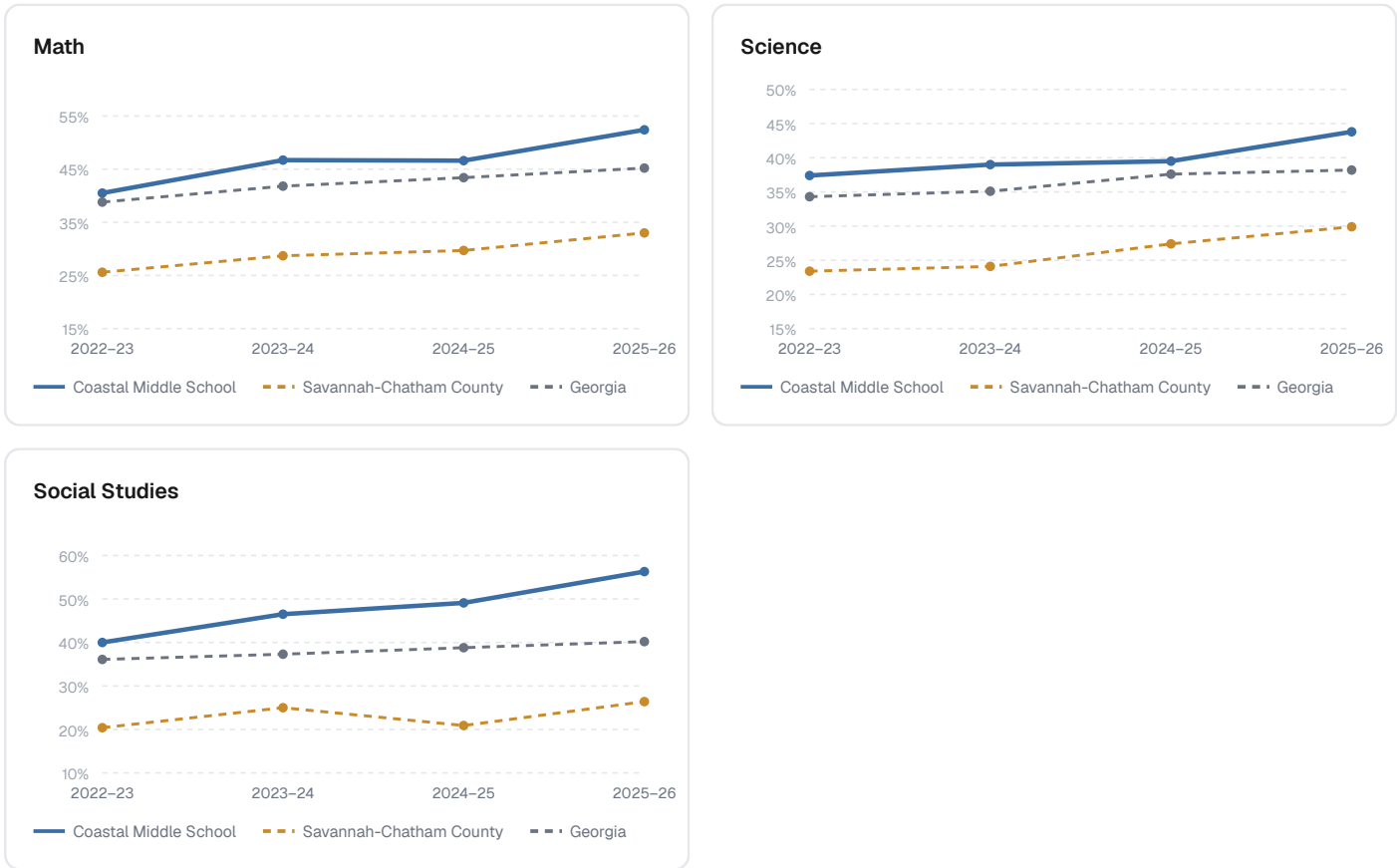
