Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Social Studies gained 34.6 points

48.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 13.8% in 2024–25.

Math has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

28.1% → 30.5% → 34.8% → 40.9% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+12.8 pts overall).

Grade 8 Social Studies gained 34.6 points

48.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 13.8% in 2024–25.

Science is 9.8 points above the state

Ellis Elementary School reported 48.0% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Social Studies is 22.0 points above the Savannah-Chatham County average

48.4% here vs. 26.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Science gained 17.1 points

48.0% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 30.9% in 2024–25.
