WHAT STANDS OUT

Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

Science gained 5.7 points

43.6% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 37.9% in 2024–25.

The Limited English Proficient gap in Science widened by 20.9 points

Limited English Proficient sat 30.5 points behind Not Limited English Proficient in 2024–25, and 51.4 points behind them in 2025–26.

Grade 4 Math lost 15.8 points

41.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 57.5% in 2024–25.

Science is 5.4 points above the state

Garden City Elementary School reported 43.6% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 38.2%.

Science is 13.7 points above the Savannah-Chatham County average

43.6% here vs. 29.9% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

Math lost 1.7 points

41.4% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 43.1% in 2024–25.

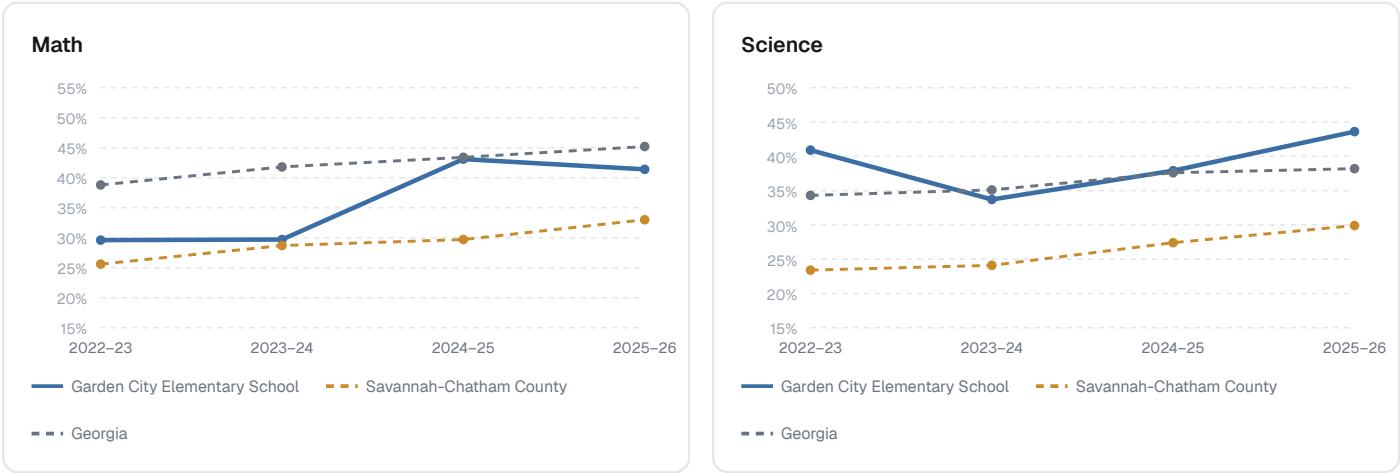
