## WHAT STANDS OUT

### Findings for 2025–26

Generated directly from the published results — every statement below can be checked against the tables in this report.

#### Science lost 8.1 points

39.5% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 47.6% in 2024–25.

#### Math has moved in one direction for 4 straight years

23.2% → 36.8% → 45.4% → 51.8% across 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25, 2025–26 (+28.6 pts overall).

#### Grade 5 Science lost 22.5 points

26.7% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, down from 49.2% in 2024–25.

#### Algebra: C&C is 41.3 points above the state

Georgetown School reported 89.4% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26; Georgia reported 48.1%.

#### Algebra: C&C is 56.6 points above the Savannah-Chatham County average

89.4% here vs. 32.8% Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26.

#### Math gained 6.4 points

51.8% of students scored Proficient or Distinguished in 2025–26, up from 45.4% in 2024–25.
